We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in June 2011.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

- 1. Special Distribution: One team of friends from Dhaka donate Sari, Lungi and Kids Cloths to Banchte Shekha. We distributed the cloth among the 250 man, women and children at Jogahati. To receive this surprised gifts community members are very happy.
 - During this month, also we distributed the Dictionary, Teachers Guide Books, Floor Mat, 2 Chair and 1 Table to the Jogahati Community. The items procured from the amount of community contribution fund.
- **2. Recruitment:** For the personal reason community motivator Nazmul has resigned from his job. The vacancy announcement has been published in local newspaper. Total 7 candidate apply for this post. Among them 3 are given written and verbal exam and BS Recruitment Committee select Mr. Shariful for the post of Community Motivator.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Four meetings are being conducted in the Jogahati and Churamankati community and the meeting topics is "Student Study at Home and Attendance at Tuition Programme".
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month, four adopted students guardian meeting are held at Jogahati, Churamankati, Lolitadaho and Mohishati. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **ten times at ten schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **9 times** at Jogahati village, **7 times** at Churamankati village, **7 times** at Lolitadaho village, **5 times** at Mohishati and **2 times** at Sorupdaho village during this month.
- **5. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Community Motivator and Tuition Teachers has visited **99** students house in **198 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme:** During this month 1-tuition teacher by rotation provided tuition support to 69 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- 7. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme: During this month, 2-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 12 adopted and 20 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 32 students receiving tuition support. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **8. LOLITADAHO Tuition Programme:** We started this tuition programme this month. One tuition teacher provides tuition support to 5 adopted and 14 not-adopted students in the

- Lolitadaho village in 2-batch. Total 19 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **9. MOHISHATI Tuition Programme:** We started this tuition programme this month. One tuition teacher provides tuition support to 10 adopted and 9 not-adopted students in the Mohishati village. Total 19 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **10. PRE-SCHOOL Programme:** During this month, 32 students of Jogahati receive the preschool service. One teacher by rotation continuously, ensures the basic education to the community kids.
- **11. School Attendance:** This month Now the **99** supported students are studying at **11** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

Notes:

- **Summary:** In the total student 105, at the exam 33 students has passed, 63 students failed and absent in exam 9 students. In the out of 33-passed student, 13 students have achieved the scholastic progress, 3 students' remains in same merit level and 17 students are declined.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason to fail and decline in exam is lack of intensive care and guidance at home. Please see the point-b in no. 1 for details explanation.
- 10. Distribution Programme: We were late to distribute the materials due to Rain and Political Strikes, finally we are able to distribute the materials at 11th July at Jogahati and

Churamankati. On 12th July distributed at Lolitadah and Moheshhati students. The distribution information is following;

- **a) Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato and 1kg Dal (lentil) to the 49 students.
- **b) Education Materials:** 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the 74 students. 3-packets of chalk to Jogahati 35 pre-school students and 2 packet of chalk to Churamankati 30 tuition students.
- c) Hygiene Materials: 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to 88 students.
- **d) Tuition Fees Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
- **e) Awareness & Motivation:** Before the distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
- f) Team: In the distribution, ceremonies BS Founder & Executive Director, Ms. Angela Gomes; Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq and General Body-Member, Mohammad Shajahan was present at the programme and distributed the materials to the students & parents.
 Community Motivator, Shoriful Islam; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Mina Das, Sonia Akter, Moushumi Jahan, Anjuara Begum and Tohmina Khatun also actively participated

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

in the distribution programmes.

- 1. Exam Result: At home, the student still does not getting proper attention or motivation from the family. We taking an action plan to overcome this problem and improve the results in next Second Terminal Exam as follows;
 - To increasing number of tuition teachers for Jogahati and Sorupdaho. Already we recruited teachers for Churamankati, Lolitadaho and Mohishati. Hope next exam the new tuition programmes will bring effect on scholastic performance.
 - To more supervision and follow-up to the tuition teachers.
 - To arrange TOT programme (Training for Teachers). It will help to develop the tuition teachers teaching skill.
 - To visiting more frequently to the students home to follow-up and supervise the students study at home.
 - To visit schools and home to check the attendance.
 - To taking extra special care with weak students.
- **2. Medical Camp:** After several rescheduling due to regular rain and frequent political strike unable to arrange the medical camp. We are planning to reschedule the programme for next month.

d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF AUGUST 2011

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

1. Teachers Co-ordination Meeting: Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be held in 7th August.

- **2. Medical Camp:** We are planning to arrange medical camp at the Jogahati community to check and identify the health problems. In the medical camp qualified physician will check and refer for the proper medical action.
- **3. Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 27th and 28th July.
