# Activities Monthly Report May 2011

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We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in May 2011.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

### a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:


1. Churamankati Visit: Some of influential members of the community harassing and keep pressuring tuition teacher and community motivator to include the rich family's children in distribution programme. They are asking why not all community children shall cover by the project and why they did not receive the materials etc.

Tuition Teacher and Community Motivator tried to convince them by telling that our project goal is to support only children from the poor families, we are not able to include students

However, they continuously giving physical and mental threat to staffs so, 5 April Project Coordinator Shourove, Monitoring Officer Mr. Anowar and Mr. Anis went to the village and sit together with all community members to identify the problem and resolve it.


More than an hour successful motivational meeting, people understood the project mission, vision and goals. After the meeting they all together promise to support the project and offer a land for the tuition programme place. We found very much lack of Community Motivator to giving proper information, communication and guidance to the community members.

- 2. Recruitment: According the project area extension and fill up the recently vacant position, we recruited the personnel in following positions:
  - **Tuition Teacher:** We call for application for the six-tuition teacher post, 2 teacher for Jogahati, 1 teacher for Churamankati, 1 teacher for Lolitadaho, 1 teacher for Mohishati and 1 teacher for Sorupdaho village. For the Jogahati 1 teacher was required but due to marriage of Teacher Rexona, she guite from her works so, we recruited two teachers for Jogahati village tuition programme. It is always very difficult to find part time tuition teacher from the surrounding community because of early marriage and drop out from the education. Finally, we able to recruit 3 fresh and young girls for the tuition programme. We very much hopeful for their best effort to educating the children and also look forward for the other 3 vacant position.
  - b) Community Motivator: For the personal reason community motivator Nazmul has resigned from his job. We shall recruit new personnel in replacement of Nazmul. Until 30th June, Nazmul will take part in the project and the meanwhile handover the responsibility.
- 3. Project Survey: During this month, we made little survey to get information about project supported students area based data. The report in graph are followings;
  - Supported Student: The Education for All project started in October'2009 and until today, we supported total 108 students.




**b) Dropout Student:** Among the 108 students, we have some dropout students. The most reason for the dropout is migration to India and do not want to study went for work etc.

**Drop-out Students** 




c) Waiting in List Student: We have 45 students are in waiting list. The village based graph is following;

### b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meetings are being conducted in the Jogahati and Churamankati community and the meeting topics is "Student School Attendance and First Terminal Examination".
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month, one adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **eight times at seven schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **8 times** at Jogahati village, **5 times** at Churamankati village, **3 times** at Lolitadaho village, **3 times** at Mohishati and **2 times** at Sorupdaho village during this month.
- 5. **Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **81** students house in **81 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme:** During this month 2-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 58 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- 7. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme: During this month, tuition teacher provide tuition support to 12 adopted and 18 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 30 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **8. PRE-SCHOOL Programme:** During this month, 32 students receive the preschool service. One teacher by rotation continuously, ensures the basic education to the community kids.
- **9. School Attendance:** Now the **105** supported students are studying at **11** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

### Notes:

• Attendance Summary: In total number of 105 students during the month 65 student's attendance at schools 100 percent; 11 students' attendance above 90 percent; 6 student's attendance above 80 percent; 16 students are below 80 percent attendance at school. 7 students are absent in the school during the month.

### Reason of Absents:

- 1. **BS0014 Basonti**; was lived in uncle house at Jogahati but last couple of months ago she went back to her parents and she do not want to return.
- 2. **BS0031 Putul**; Due to parents quarrel and separate living of parents, she went with her mom to living at Grandparents house.
- 3. **BS0042 Milon**; does not want to study anymore so, he went to work and now work as a bus helper.
- 4. **BS0044 Shohag**; also does not want to study anymore because he thinks that at Army he can make his carrier so, he went to nearest Army camp and work in the mess.
- 5. **BS0061 Yusuf**; does not want to study anymore so, he went to work and now work as a day labour.
- 6. **BS0087 Joy/Nondini**; The adopted student was Joy but during last year, during Dr. Maria visit and our observation we started to support Nondini instead of her brother Joy at Churamankati. This month Nondini went to visit the relative house for that reason she was absent in school.
- 7. **BS0089 Anonto**; went to relative house for the "NAM JOGGO" (Hindu Ritual Festival) for that reason she was absent in school.

This month school was open for fewer days because of the summer vacation. In addition, Students are less attends at school because of "NAM JOGGO" (Hindu Ritual Festival). Other less attendance at School is for seasonal fever and relative house visit.

- **9. Distribution Programme:** We distributed the materials at 30<sup>th</sup> May at Jogahati and Churamankati. 31<sup>st</sup> May distributed at Lolitadah and Moheshhati students. The distribution information is followings;
  - **a) Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato, 1kg Dal (lentil), 1ltr Soybean Oil and 1kg Salt to the 69 students.
  - **Education Materials:** 1 piece Copy Books and 1 piece Pen to the 82 students. 6-packets of chalk to Jogahati 35 pre-school students and 3 packet of chalk to Churamankati 30 tuition students.
  - c) Hygiene Materials: 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to 99 students.

- **d) Tuition Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
- e) Awareness & Motivation: Before the distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
- f) Team: In the distribution, ceremonies BS Founder & Executive Director, Ms. Angela Gomes; Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Project Co-ordinator- Shourove Ansari and BS Guest- BaSE Management Consultant Mr. Davide Daniele was present at the programme and distributed the materials to the students & parents.

  Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Mina Das, Sonia Akter and new 3 teacher of the Churamankati, Lolitadaho and Mohishati also actively participated in the distribution programme.

# c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. **Absent at School:** During this month 7 student totally absent at school. Community Motivator and Tuition Teachers is closely follow-up these students and shall identify the proper solution to send back them to school again.

# d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF June 2011

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

- **1. New Tuition Programme:** New recruited teachers will be starting the tuition programme at Churamankati, Lolitadaho and Mohishati village from 1<sup>st</sup> of June.
- **2. Teachers Co-ordination Meeting:** Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be held in 8th June.
- **3. Medical Camp:** We are planning to arrange medical camp at the Jogahati community to check and identify the health problems. In the medical camp qualified physician will check and refer for the proper medical action.
- **4. Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> June.
