Project Activities Report

April 2012

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We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in April 2012.

During this month, we were busy to continue our regular work. We are very happy and express greetings to the IDEA Onlus team to organise the “Marathon di Milano”. We hope this initiative will bring the light of education to more disadvantage children in Bangladesh.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITIES

- 1. Volunteers:** Cantonment Collage, Social Science Students make internship in Education for All project. Part of their internship we brief about the project mission, vision and objectives. Total 15 students making the internship and they are very enthusiastic to know about Education for All project motto. The student provides the volunteer support in materials packing and distribution. The Cantonment Collage is one of the best and reputed collage in Jessore and as well as in Bangladesh. We are very happy to introduce and transform the IDEA Onlus and Education for All project activities to the students. The students astonished to see the outstanding works and they express thanks to BS and IDEA for this great work. We hope the demonstration will give them inspiration and dedication in their future working life.
- 2. Sports Materials:** We distributed sports materials to Churmankati & Mohishati students. During their leisure time, they will play and enjoy the sport. Students are very happy to receive Football, Skipping-rope, Ludo etc.
- 3. Churamankati Study Centre:** We are very happy that finally we receive the land for construction of the Churamankati study centre. Mr. Shanti Das community member and our sponsor child Biplob (BS0082) father generously convinced to provide his unused land to construct the Study Centre. We are very happy for his involvement and contribution to the Education for All project.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

- 1. Guardians’ Meetings:** During this month, **7** guardians meeting was arrange at Jogahati, Churamankati, Lolitadaho, Mohishati and Sorupdaho village. In these meetings, we discuss on the role of the parents at home and student’s attentiveness into the study at school & home. In the meetings, Guardians participated actively.
- 2. School Visits:** During the month, to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator visited **eleven schools**.
- 3. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, students study at home and to supervise the tuition programmes- Community Motivator visited **9 times** at Jogahati village, **7 times** at Churamankati village, **4 times** at Lolitadaho village, **3 times** at Mohishati and **3 times** at Sorupdaho village during this month.
- 4. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers and Community Motivator together and separately visited all the **133** student’s houses during this month. The door-to-door visit ensures the family involvement with project & student study, progresses for domestic cattle’s care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials, kitchen gardening etc.

5. **Tuition Programme:** To improve student's school attendance and scholastic development every working days tuition teachers providing after school study support to the students. Through this programme, we ensuring study progress of the student. The monthly data as follows;

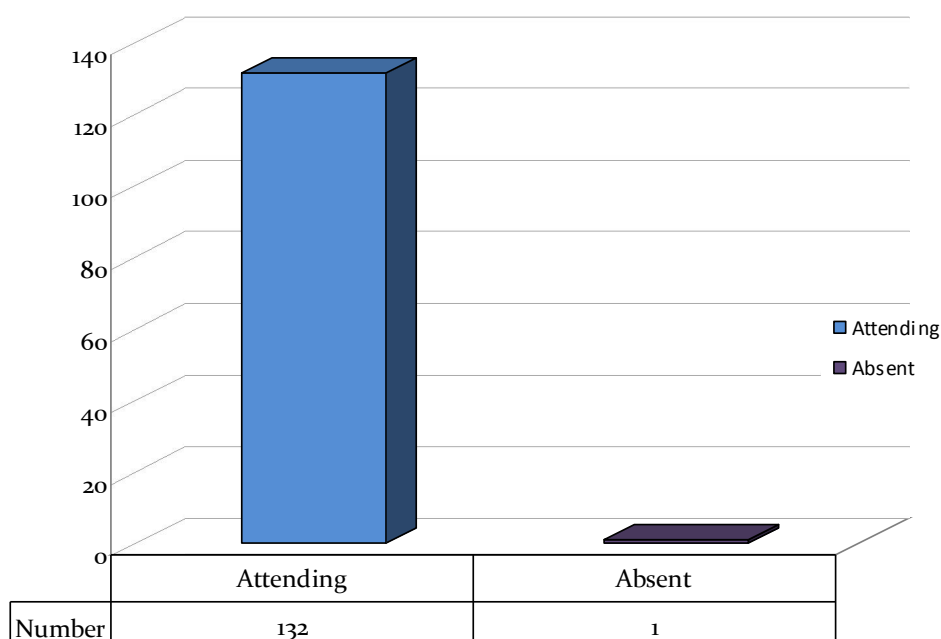
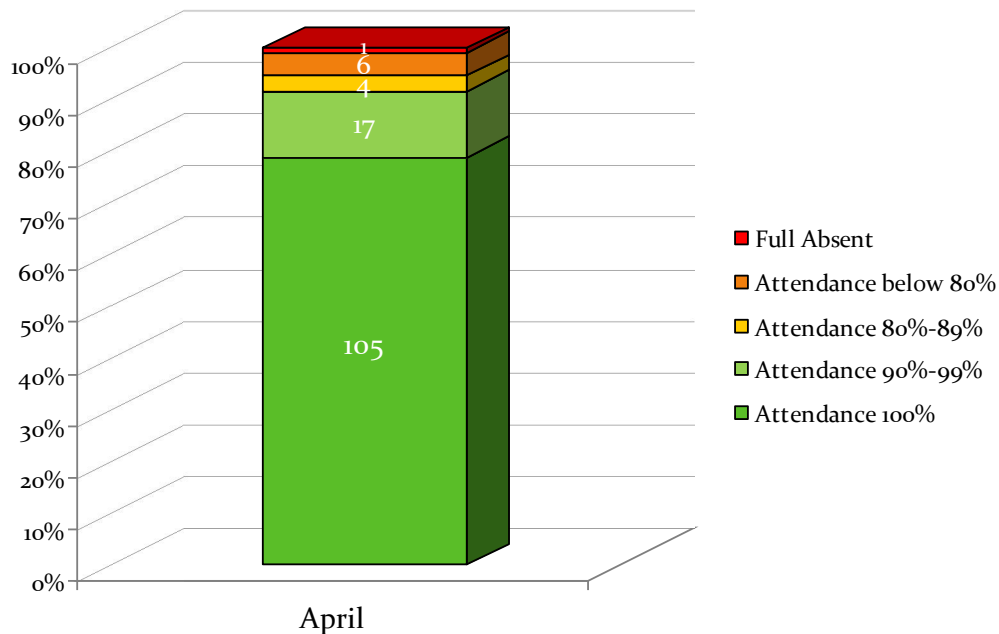

Notes:

- **Attendance Summary:** Total number of 133 adopted students, during this month 105 students attended 100% days at classes; 17 students attended above 90% days at classes; 4 students attended above 80% days at classes and 6 students attended below 80% days at classes. 1 students were totally absent at school.
- **Reason of Absents:** During this month, some students less attends at school for the fever and relatives house visit.

8. Distribution Programme: We distributed the materials in 16th at Jogahati & Churamankati; 17th at Lolitadaho & Mohishati and 18th at Sorupdaho. Due to absent among the 133 students, total 127 students receive the following support during this month;

- a) **Nutrition Materials:** To ensure basic nutrition support to the Jogahati extreme poor families, we distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato, 1kg Dhal (lentil) to the 55 adopted students and families.
- b) **Education Materials:** To continuation of the smooth study, we distributed 2piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to 108 adopted students. Also, distributes 9 packets of chalk to tuition and pre-school programme.
- c) **Hygiene Materials:** To cleanliness and improve personal-hygiene, we distribute 1piece Body Soap and 2piece Washing Soap to 131 adopted students.
- d) **Tuition Fees:** To cover the regular education expenses, we provided tuition fees to the 4 adopted students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
- e) **Awareness & Motivation:** Before the distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance of the education among the students and parents.
- f) **Team:** In the distribution ceremonies Governing Body-Treasurer, Mr. Moqsudul Haq; Jessore Govt. Cantonment Collage 15 students was present at the programmes and distributed the materials.
Community Motivator, Mr. Shoriful Islam; Tuition Teachers- Miss. Sufia Khatun, Mrs. Mina Das, Mrs. Shamimunnahar, Miss. Shila Khatun, Miss. Sonia Akter, Miss. Moushumi Jahan, Miss. Anjuara Begum, Miss. Tohmina Khatun, Miss. Sharmin Akhtar also actively participated in the distribution programmes.

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. **Jogahati School Relocation:** We finally found the location at Churamankati. Now we are searching location for Jogahati tuition programme. Tuition programme & pre-school operating in the one of community member house yard. The place is inconvenient and owners want the land back so, we are searching the proper place for relocation. Hope soon we will find and arrange the relocation of the Centre soon.

d. ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR May 2012

Beside the regular activities of the project, following initiative shall take in upcoming month:

1. **Teachers Co-ordination Meeting:** Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be hold in 5th May.
2. **Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 14th, 15th and 16th May.
3. **Churamankati Tuition Study Centre:** We are going to construct the Churamankati study centre during this month.

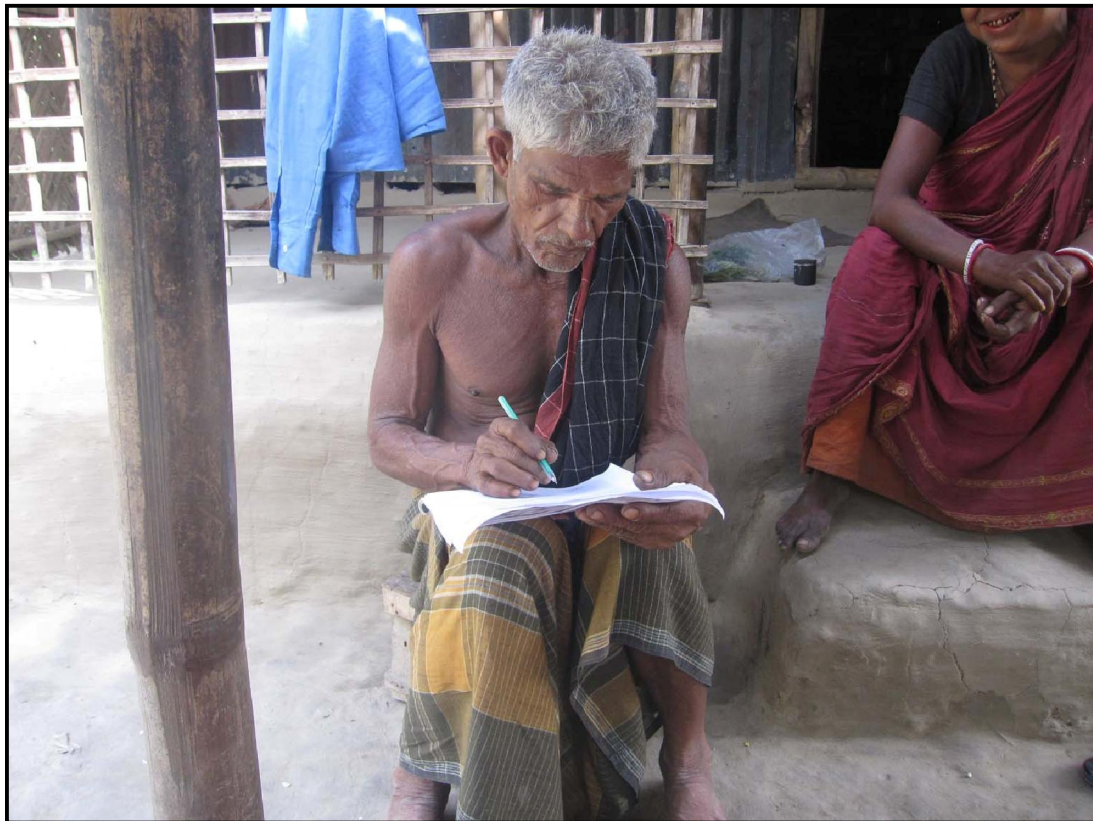
