We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in April 2013.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITIES

- 1. Visit:** BaSE two designer friends, Ms. Emanuela Leombruni and Ms. Carolina Manclossi has visited Jogahati village. The friends are very happy to see BS-IDEA project activities and express thanks to IDEA for the great support for the disadvantage people.
- 2. Materials for All:** According the BS-IDEA mutual decision we started the distribution education & hygiene materials to all students and community. Before only adopted children received the materials. The children and families are very happy.
- 3. Special Support:** BaSE (the handicrafts partner organisation of BS) provides Note Book, Crayons, Pencil, Ruler, Papers to 50 children of the Jogahati community.
- 4. Tuition Teacher Recruitment:** We recruited new tuition teacher for Mohishati tuition programme in 10th April. The new teacher name is SONIA NASRIN and she started work from 15th of April. Ms. Nasrin study into Finance in honours and from the Mohishati community. Her father is poor farmer and she is only girl at the family who studying at this level. Ms. Nasrin is responsible to teach 20 new non-adopted students of Mohishati community. We hope she will provide a extraordinary performance to the project.
- 5. Exam:** In the beginning of May, first-term exam will be start at all school. Our teachers and students are very busy to preparation for the exam.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

- 1. Guardians' Meetings:** During this month, **7** guardians meeting was arrange at Jogahati, Churamankati, Lolitadaho, Mohishati and Sorupdaho village. In these meetings, we discuss on the role of the parents at home and student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. In the meetings, Guardians participated actively.
- 2. School Visits:** During the month, to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator visited **twelve schools**.
- 3. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, students study at home and to supervise the tuition programmes- Community Motivator visited **13 times** at Jogahati village, **10 times** at Churamankati village, **5 times** at Lolitadaho village, **5 times** at Mohishati and **3 times** at Sorupdaho village during this month.
- 4. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers and Community Motivator together and separately visited all the **140** student's houses during this month. The door-to-door visit ensures the family involvement with project & student study, progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials, kitchen gardening etc.
- 5. Tuition Programme:** To improve student's school attendance and scholastic development every working days tuition teachers providing after school study support to the students. Through this programme, we ensuring study progress of the student. The monthly data as follows;

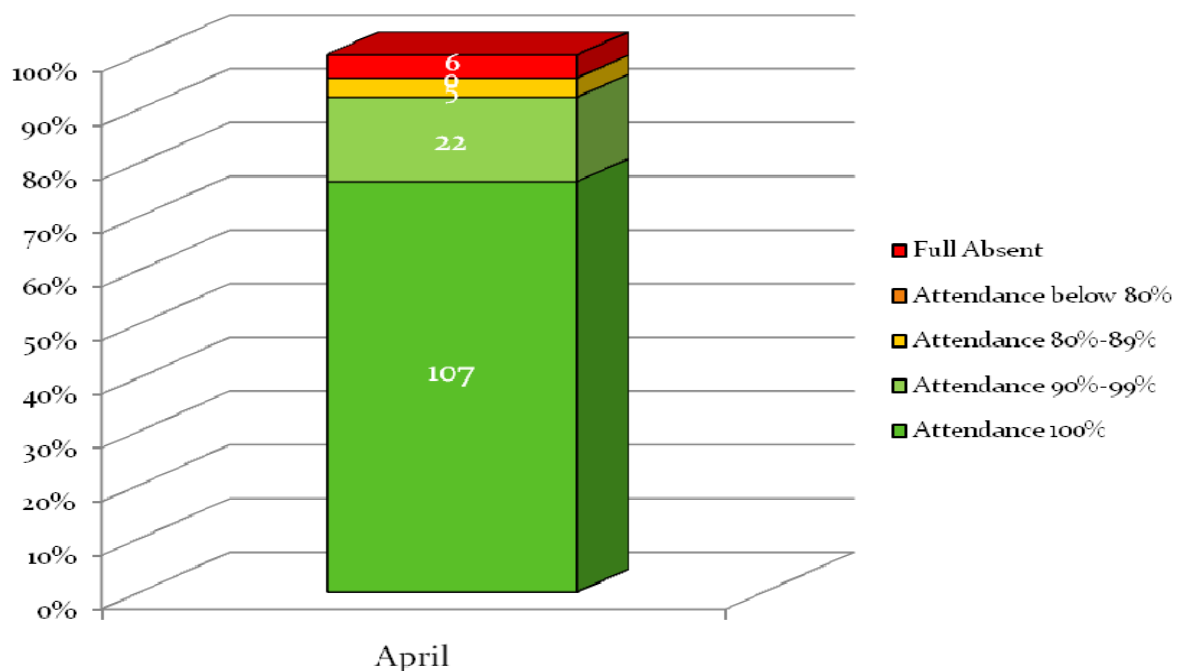

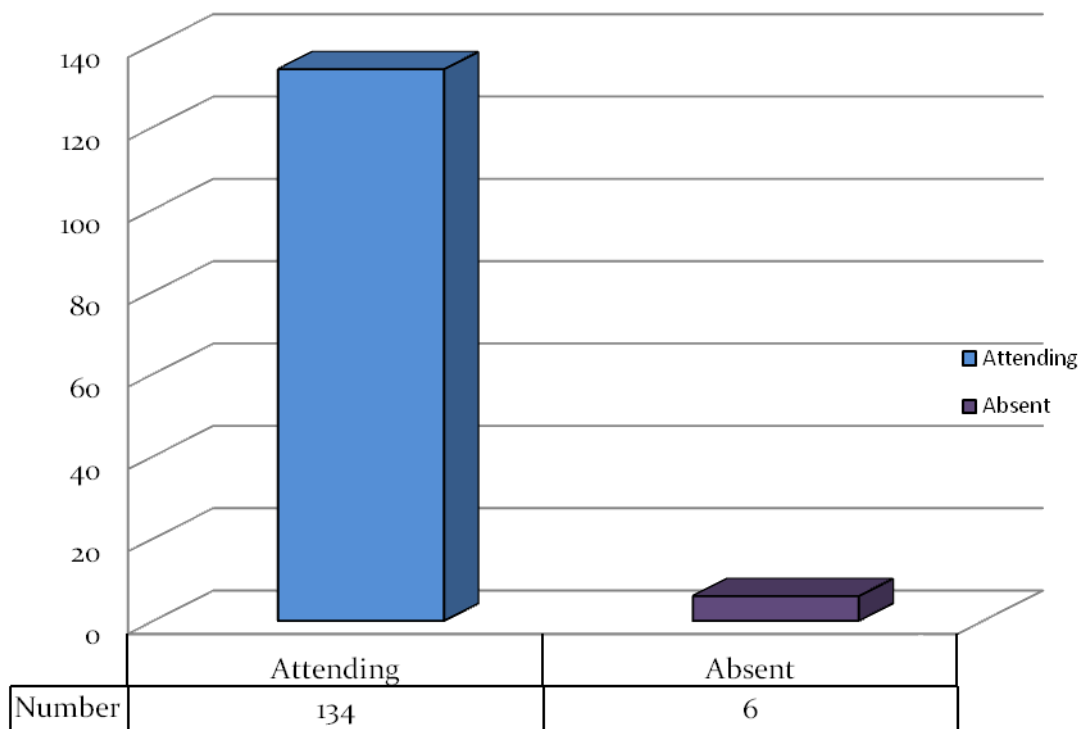

Notes:

- **Attendance Summary:** Total number of 140 adopted students, during this month 107 students attended 100% days at classes; 22 students attended above 90% days at classes, 5 student attended above 80% days at classes. 6 students were totally absent at school.
- **Absents:** During the month total 6 student was absent. Among this 6 students, two students family has been left home without giving any notice because of loan defaulted. 1 students get married! 2 students don't want to study anymore. 1 student went to India to visit relatives.

8. Distribution Programme: We distributed the materials in 16th at Jogahati; 17th at Lolitadaho & Mohishati; 18th at Sorupdaho and 22th at Churamankati month of April. For equal distribution from this month, we included adopted and non-adopted students in materials coverage. So, the following support provided during this month;

- a) **Nutrition Materials:** To ensure basic nutrition support to the Jogahati extreme poor children we providing warm 'Khitchury' (hotchpotch) every school days to 31 kids. The 'Khitchury' cooked each day by different mothers according a cooking schedule. For preparing the 'Khitchury' we providing Rice, Potato, Dhal (lentil), Soybean Oil, Salt, Garlic, Onion etc.
Vegetables for the 'Khitchury' are provided by parents and collected from kitchen gardens. Children enjoyed total 25 days warm Khitchury during this month.
In each tuition classes, students receive pack of biscuits everyday. Total 195 children receive the biscuits in every tuition classes for 25 days in this month. The biscuit helps children daily nutrition as well as motivating to attend tuition programme daily.
- b) **Education Materials:** To continuation of the smooth study, we distributed 3piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to 195 adopted and non-adopted students. Also, distributed 9packet Black board Chalk to the tuition centre and pre-school.
- c) **Hygiene Materials:** To cleanliness and improve personal-hygiene, we distribute 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap to 240 adopted, non-adopted students and communities families.
- d) **Tuition Fees:** To cover the regular education expenses, we provided tuition fees to the 4 adopted students and the students are Alryma-Amlina Sarkar (BS0023), Karuna Rani Das (BS0098) & Boishakhi Rani Das (BS0099), Jamena Khatun (BS0119).
- e) **Awareness & Motivation:** Before the each distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance of the education among the students and parents.

f) **Team:** In distribution, ceremonies BS-Accountant Mr. Isharat Hossain attend in the programmes and distributed the materials. Community Motivator- Mr. Shoriful Islam; Tuition Teachers- Miss. Sufia Khatun, Mrs. Mina Das, Mrs. Shamimunnahar, Miss. Shila Khatun, Miss. Sonia Akter, Mrs. Moushumi Jahan, Miss. Anjuara Begum, Miss. Sharmin Akhtar, Miss. Tohmina Khatun, Miss. Sonia Nasrin also actively participated in the distribution programmes.

c. **ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR May 2013**

Beside the regular activities of the project, following initiative shall take in upcoming month:

1. **Teachers Co-ordination Meeting:** Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be hold in 5th May.

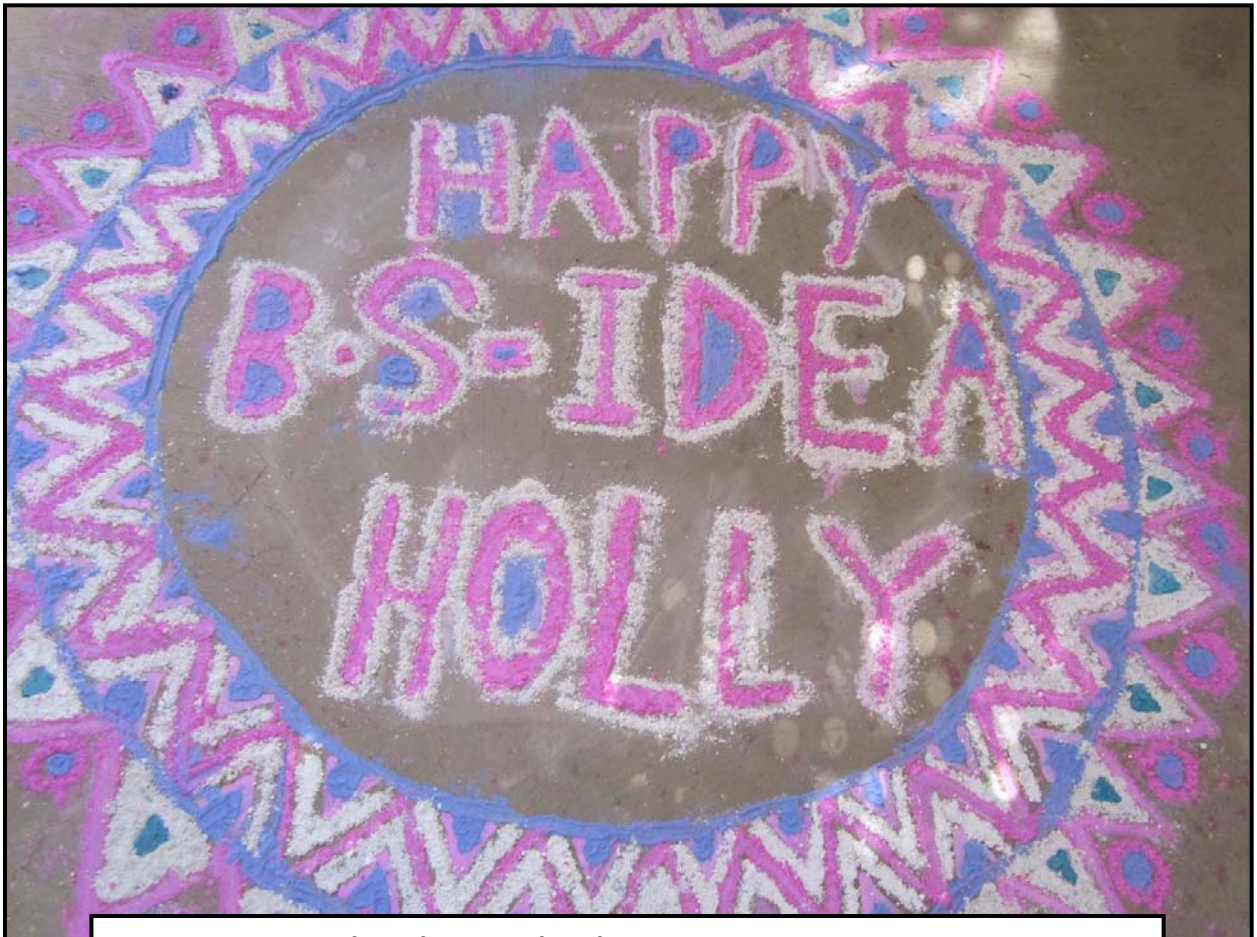
