# Activities Monthly Report March 2011

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We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in March 2011.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

#### a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

1. Mosquito-net Distribution: Friend of Banchte Shekha Professor of MM (Michael Madhusudan Dutt) Collage Prof. Mostafizur Rahman again distributed generously Mosquito-net to the 15 most poor family of the Jogahati village. Last January he was distributed also the winter clothe and foods to the villagers. We are very grateful and it is an example of the local people participation in the project.

### b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meetings are being conducted in the community and the meeting topics is "Health, Hygiene and Cleanliness".
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month, two adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati and Churamankati. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **twelve times at five schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **13 times** at Jogahati village, **3 times** at Churamankati village, **2 times** at Lolitadaho village, and **2 times** at Mohishati village during this month.
- 5. **Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **70** students house in **70 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme:** During this month 2-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 63 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- 7. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme: During this month, tuition teacher provide tuition support to 12 adopted and 24 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 36 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **8. PRE-SCHOOL Programme:** During this month, 35 students receive the preschool service. One teacher by rotation continuously, ensures the basic education to the community kids.
- **9. School Attendance:** Now the **105** supported students are studying at **11** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

#### Notes:

- Attendance Summary: Total number 105 students during the month 66 student's attendance at schools 100 percent; 20 students' attendance above 90 percent; 10 students attendance above 80 percent; 5 students are below 80 percent attendance at school. 4 students are not attend in the school during the month.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason of students less school attendance is for seasonal fever, chicken pox and relative house visit.
- **9. Distribution Programme:** We have set the date to distribution the materials in 31<sup>st</sup> of March but due to administrative reasons, the distribution was made in 10<sup>th</sup> April at Jogahati & Churamankati students and 11<sup>th</sup> April at Lolitadah & Moheshhati students. The distribution information is followings;
  - **a)** Nutrition Materials: We distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato and 1kg Dal (lentil) to the 70 students
  - **b) Education Materials:** 1 piece Copy Books and 1 piece Pen to the 82 students. 6-packets of chalk to Jogahati 35 pre-school students and 3 packet of chalk to Churamankati 36 tuition students.
  - **c) Hygiene Materials:** 1 piece Body Soap and 1 piece Washing Soap has been given to 97 students.
  - **d) Tuition Support**: The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
  - **e) Awareness & Motivation:** Before the each distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress and motivate on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
  - f) Team: In the distribution, ceremonies Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq, General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan was present at the programme and distributed the materials to the students & parents. Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Rexona Khatun, Mina Das & Sonia Akter also actively participates in the distribution programme.

1. **Absent at School**: During this month 4 student totally not went to school. Most reason of absent in school is change the living address and family problems. Community Motivator will closely follow-up those students and shall identify the proper solution to send back them to school.

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

- **1. Approval:** We complete and submit the 2010 project external financial audit report. Waiting to get bank certificate from NGO Affairs Bureau of Bangladesh (NGOAB).
- **2. Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> April.
- **3. Teachers Co-ordination Meeting:** Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be held in 25<sup>th</sup> of April.
