EDUCATION FOR ALL PROJECT

Activities Monitoring Report: April 2010

We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in April 2010.

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings:** Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Three meetings are being conducted in the community, and special topics include the importance of education, cleanliness, health & hygiene, kitchen/yard gardening, dangers of early marriage, malnutrition, care of pet goats and other issues, vital for the well being of their children etc.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings:** During this month one adopted students guardians meeting has arranged in the community. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians have actively participated in the meetings.
- 3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited nine times in five schools.
- 4. Medical Support:** Two disabled girls LUCKY & ASMA has been visited by an assistive device expert from Khulna.

According to the last month Dhaka specialist recommendation and suggestion, the assistive device expert takes measurement to preparing the special corrective shoes, back-slab & elbow crutches for Lucky and Asma.
- 5. Pre-school:** Community Motivator took 3 classes in pre-school on English, Bangla & Arithmetic beside the regular class routine.
- 6. New Sponsorship:** 11 new students (Nishikanto, Madhobi, Bonomali, Pia, Mithun, Shukhdev, Deshpremik, Minoti, Porimol, Shushmita & Al-amin) are enrolled in the project.
- 7. Survey on Housing Condition:** 1 – 3 April conducted the Jogahati community survey on Housing Condition. In the survey, we found that in number of 81 families, need urgent housing support to 37 families and repairing support to 17 families.
- 8. Survey on IGA:** 4 – 5 April conducted the Jogahati community survey on IGA Needs. The survey conducted to 81 families, and found that 120 male & female members need to be enrolled for the income generation activities such as; Fish net, Cow rearing, Fish business, handicrafts, Van-rickshaw, Barbershop etc.
- 9. School Attendance List:** Now the 73 supported students are studying at 5 different schools, the attendance reports are given below;

- Green for above 90%; Blue for above 80%; Red for below 80% attendance.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason to un-attendants at schools is for Chickenpox, Seasonal Fever & Relative House visit. Last 14th April we celebrated the Bangla New Year for that reason most of child visit the relative houses. Also, now in Bangladesh is summer season, too hot climate and no rain last six months; so some of children get fever &

chickenpox. We conducted awareness meetings with parents and students on care & prevention of fever and chickenpox on summer.

10. Distribution Programme: 26th April we arranged the distribution programme for 73 students.

- a) **Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 10kg Rice, 1kg Dal (lentil), 1ltr Soyabin Oil & 1kg Salt among the students.
- b) **Education Materials:** 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pencil to the students.
- c) **Hygiene Materials;** 1piece Body Soap & 1piece Washing Soap has been given to students.
- d) **Tuition Support:** Provided tuition costs to Amlina for the month of April.
- e) **Awareness Song:** During the programme, Balai Das Baul sang some beautiful awareness song on cleanliness and unity-togetherness.
- f) **BS Team:** In the distribution ceremony BS Executive Director, Angela Gomes; Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Pre-school Teacher, Sufia Khatun ; Micro-credit PO, Sohel Khan was attended the programme and distributed the materials to the students.

The following project activity plans are prepare for the month of May 2010 :

1. **Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings** shall conduct at the community.
2. **Guardians' Meetings** shall arrange with the adopted student parents.
3. **School Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up students study and school attendance.
4. **Community Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up community activities and conduct the development activities.
5. **Special Support:** In this month we are planning to provide two cows to the two poorest families of the Jogahati Community to generation the daily income. The support will arrange by the financial help of Andrea - Barbara Family and Anna Maria Valletta - Arturo Merrone Family.
6. **Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the distribution programme at 31st May.
7. **NGO Bureau Renewal:** We are waiting to get the approval of the "Education for All" renewal project from the NGO bureau for further 3-years.
8. **New PROJECT:** We are going to submit the PRERONA-Project for participatory collaboration in disadvantaged community development, proposal to the NGO bureau.
