We spent wonderful time with Edo (Edoardo). It was good exchange and experience for us to working with Edo. We successfully completed 2011. During the year we make lot of effort to achieve our objective and goals. Confidently and proudly we can tell you that we are on the track to achieve our objective and goals. During the year many new student enrolled in the project. We started tuition programme at every working community. All the year students school attendance graph going up. And end of the year we found more than 85% student has passed which remarkable achievement if we consider the first terminal and second terminal exam results. It is also satisfying that parents now make the effort to send their children to school, despite the problems they have. Through motivation, parents are increasingly aware of the real and long-term value of education.

We are very happy but not satisfied... Therefore, for the year 2012 we want to move forward with more motivation and determination to achieving to our goals.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES

- 1. Medical Camp:** After the several medical camp schedule break we finally able to conduct the Medical Camp at Jogahati. According the Medical Survey report, Physician screening the patient and total 72 patients receive the medical check-up and advice. Later according the prescription we provided medicine to the 68 patients of Jogahati Community. As you know, the community peoples do not have the ability to reach proper medical consultation. Medical Camp gives the opportunity to take and get specialized medical support.
- 2. Tuition Study Centre:** We completed the constructing of Sorupdaho tuition study centre. Now student able to take tuition classes in proper place instead of Varanda. During the construction process community people actively participated by providing physical labour and materials. We thanks to all.....
- 3. Winter Cloth Distribution:** Now is winter season in Bangladesh. Usually the minimum temperature in winter season in Bangladesh around 12/14 degree Celsius. But recently the temperature drop to 6 degree Celsius, which is very difficult for the people. Especially, the poor families, who don't have proper warm cloths and living structures. To consider the present cold situation BS arranged warm cloth distribution programme by the financial support of BS Local Friends. We distributed total 210 blankets and shawl to the Jogahati and Sorupdaho most poor families. Thanks to friends for supporting the most required items in most crucial time.
- 4. Christmas Lunch:** To celebrate the Christmas Miss Angela Gomes founder Executive Director arrange lunch programme for the Sorupdaho children at BS office. In 25th morning, 22 children came to BS and took lunch with Miss. Angela Gomes. For the first time they make out from their community together to celebrate the day. It was full of fun and picnic for the children. End of the day before return back home they received new warm cloths and blankets. We are very happy to make Joy-day for the kids.
- 5. Maria Martin and Gabriele Bresso Visit:** We are very happy to welcome Maria and Gabriele in Bangladesh. We spending very effective time and received technical and professional

guidance and suggestion to improve the project activities. We express our grateful thanks to Maria and Gabriele for coming to see us and sacrificing Christmas holidays.

- 6. School Final Exam Result:** During the month, our students, parents and teachers spent very busy time for School Final Examination. We are very happy to say that more than 85% children had passed in the exam.

Especially for the first time students given the PSC (Primary School Certificate) exam. The PSC is board exam which has been newly introduced by the government to ensure the quality education. In PSC exam 8 student given exam and has passed all 8 student. We congratulate our students, parents and teachers for their joint effort for this good result.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

- Guardians' Meetings:** During this month, 7 guardians meeting was arrange at Jogahati, Churamankati, Lolitadaho, Mohishati and Sorupdaho village. In these meetings, we discuss on the role of the parents at home and student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. In the meetings, Guardians participated actively.
- School Visits:** During the month, to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator visited **twelve schools**.
- Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, students study at home and to supervise the tuition programmes, Community Motivator visited **10 times** at Jogahati village, **6 times** at Churamankati village, **3 times** at Lolitadaho village, **3 times** at Mohishati and **5 times** at Sorupdaho village during this month.
- Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers and Community Motivator together and separately visited all the **130** student's houses during this month. The door-to-door visit ensures the family involvement with project & student study, progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials, kitchen gardening etc.
- Tuition Programme:** To improve student's school attendance and scholastic development every working days tuition programmes is conducting at the Communities. Through this programme, we ensuring the study progress of the student. The monthly data as follows;

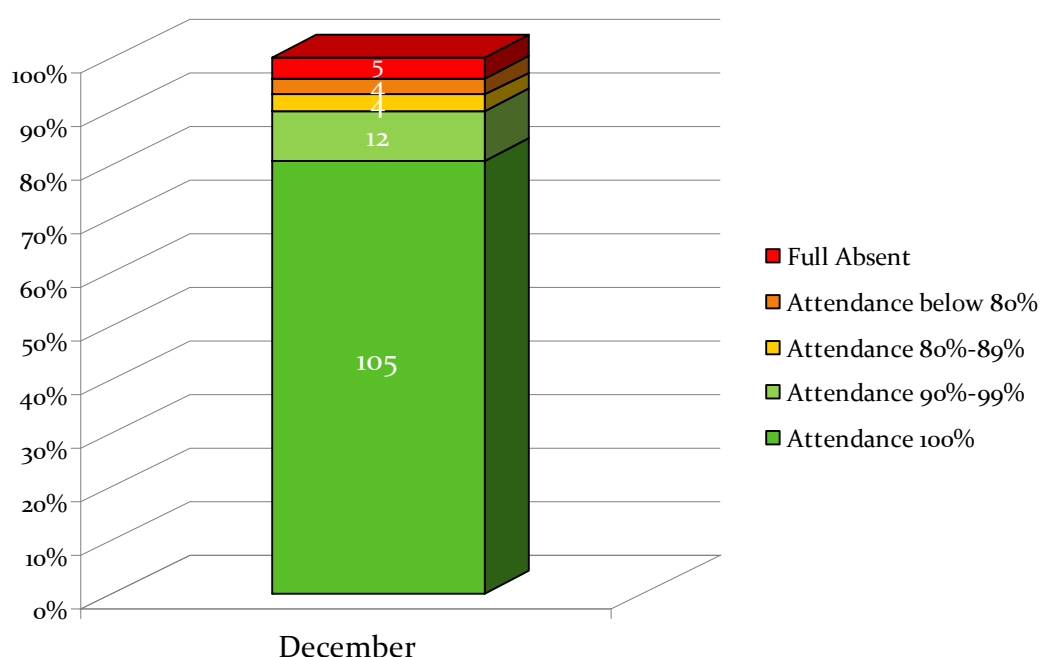

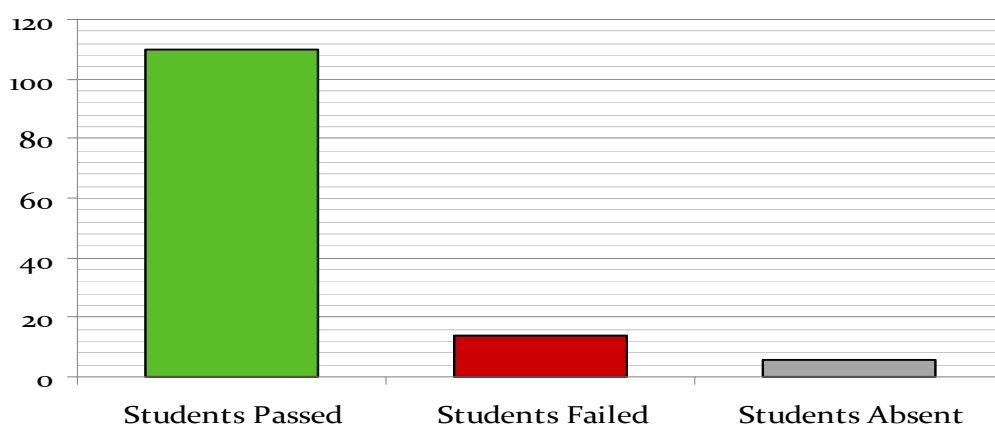

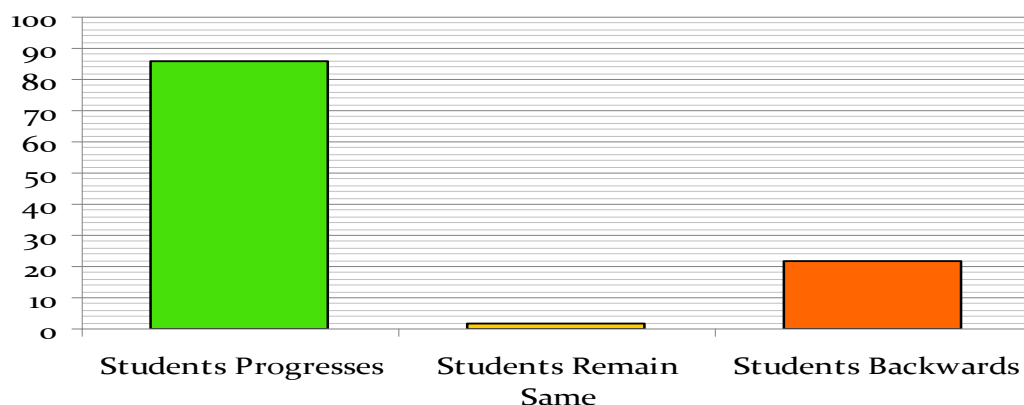

8. **Distribution Programme:** We distributed the materials in 12th at Jogahati & Churamankati; 13th at Lolitadaho & Mohishati and 14th at Sorupdaho. Due to absent among the 130 students, total 114 students receive the following support during this month;
- a) **Nutrition Materials:** To ensure basic nutrition support to the Jogahati extreme poor families, we distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato, 1kg Dhal (lentil) to the 57 adopted students and families.
 - b) **Education Materials:** To continuation of the smooth study, we distributed 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to 107 adopted students. Also, distributes 6 packets of chalk to tuition and pre-school programme.
 - c) **Hygiene Materials:** To cleanliness and improve personal-hygiene, we distribute 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap to 114 adopted students.
 - d) **Tuition Fees:** To cover the regular education expenses, we provided tuition fees to the 4 adopted students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
 - e) **Awareness & Motivation:** Before the distribution, BS Intern Guest and Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance of final examination among the students and parents.
 - f) **Team:** In the distribution ceremonies Intern, Mr. Edoardo Trimarchi; BS Governing Body-Treasurer, Mr. Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan was present at the programmes and distributed the materials. Community Motivator, Mr. Shoriful Islam; Tuition Teachers- Miss. Sufia Khatun, Mrs. Mina Das, Mrs. Shamimunnahar, Miss. Shila Khatun, Miss. Sonia Akter, Miss. Moushumi Jahan, Miss. Anjuara Begum, Miss. Tohmina Khatun, Miss. Sharmin Akhtar also actively participated in the distribution programmes.

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. **Teachers Training:** We were unable to arrange the Teachers Training programme according the plan due to final examination and holidays. In 2012, we will conduct the training to improve the teaching skills of tuition teachers.
2. **Exam Result:** According the comparison of the last exams result, we found good results in final exam. Although we are not satisfy for that reason we keep continuing the following plan to get good results in 2012:
 - To improved teaching quality, we will evaluate teacher's performance and provide the intensive bonus to best teacher.
 - To check teacher performance Community Motivator will frequently visit to tuition programmes and students home.
 - To develop the teaching quality we will arrange TOT programme (Training of Teachers).
 - To increase the student's attendance at the School and Tuition, Community Motivator & Teachers will visit frequently to the school and Home. .
 - For better results in school, Tuition Teachers will take Monthly Evaluation Exam according the Syllabus.
 - To improve the weak student's performance Teachers will take extra and special care.

d. **ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR FY 2012**

Beside the regular activities of the project, following initiative shall take in upcoming year:

1. **Attendance:** Every month we will work to increase 100% school and tuition class attendance for more than 85% student.
2. **Exam Result Target:** The annual exam-wise target result is following;
1st Terminal Exam: Above 85% students must pass and increase class position.
2nd Terminal Exam: Above 90% students must pass and increase class position.
Final Exam: Above 95%, student must pass with best result.
3. **Ensure Quality Tuition:** To ensure quality education in tuition programme we will arrange Teachers Training at January. In addition, to follow-up student study progress every month we will conduct evaluation exam according the class syllabus.
4. **Teacher Performance Bonus:** To improve teacher's performance and motivation we will provide intensive bonus in exam results. The teachers will receive performance bonus if results reach the above-mentioned target (see point-d in no. 2).
5. **Art & Cultural Classes:** To improve the student cultural skills and bring out the hidden talent, every month we will conduct cultural classes at the Tuition Programme. In classes student will do drawing, presentation of poetry, will tell story, singing and dancing. After all the days, hard studies cultural classes will give learn and fun opportunity to the student.
6. **Drawing Competition:** To collect 2012 greetings card design in September we will conduct drawing competition at all tuition programme. The best drawing will nominated for the 2012 adopted parent's Christmas greetings card.
7. **Study Centre Relocation & Reconstruction:** During the year, we will select convenient place for the Jogahati & Churamankati Tuition Programme. Now using veranda and their have lack of toilet, water & free space facilities. Therefore, new place selected with lots of much space where we can establish Toilets and other facilities. The school relocation & reconstruction process and implementation will made with community people joint effort. The community people will provide unused land space and physical contribution to relocation and construction of the Study Centre.
8. **Medical Camp:** We will conduct medical camp in June and December 2012. The physician will visit students and community people to check-up the health problems and provide medical support accordingly.
9. **Kitchen Gardening:** The importance of optimal nutrition for health and human development is well recognized. Kitchen gardens are found useful at many places. These gardens have an established tradition and offer great potential for improving household food security and alleviating micronutrient deficiencies. Gardening can enhance food security in several ways, most importantly through: 1) direct access to a diversity of nutritionally rich foods, 2) increased purchasing power from savings on food and income from sales of garden products, and 3) Availability of fresh vegetables at the fingertips. This is especially important in rural areas where people have limited income-earning opportunities and poor access to markets. Kitchen gardens are also becoming an increasingly important source of food and income for poor households. Last year

before we found good success in Kitchen Gardening revolution so, in 2012 we will conduct the door-to-door kitchen garden at our working community.

10. Teachers Co-ordination Meeting: Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be hold during the year.

11. Materials Distribution: We will conduct **distribution** programme through out the year according the budget plan.

12. PRERONA project will start from July and through the project Vocational Training, Income Generation Support, Housing Support shall be given to the Jogahati Community People.
