We passed a year and happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in February 2011.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

## a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

1. Motorcycle for the Field Work: According the budget allocation we bought the Motorcycle for the fieldwork. The motorcycle will improve the day-to-day activities of the Community Motivator at field.

### **b.** THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meetings are being conducted in the community and the meeting topics is "School and tuition class attendance of the children".
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month two adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati and Churamankati. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **fourteen times at nine schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **14 times** at Jogahati village, **4 times** at Churamankati village, **4 times** at Lolitadaho village, and **5 times** at Mohishati village during this month.
- **5. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **74** students house in **148 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme:** During this month 3-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 51 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- 7. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme: During this month, tuition teacher provide tuition support to 12 adopted and 24 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 36 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- **8. School Attendance:** Now the **105** supported students are studying at **11** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

### Notes:

- Attendance Summary: Total number 105 students during the month 70 students attendance at schools 100 percent; 12 students attendance above 90 percent; 12 students attendance above 80 percent; 7 students are below 80 percent attendance at school. 4 students are not attend in the school during the month.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason of students less school attendance is for fever and relative house visit.
- **9. Distribution Programme:** We have set the date to distribution the materials in 31<sup>st</sup> January but due to administrative reasons, the distribution was made in 20<sup>th</sup> Feb at Jogahati & Churamankati students and 28<sup>th</sup> Feb at Lolitadah & Moheshhati students. The distribution information is followings;
  - **a) Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 8kg Rice, 1kg Potato, 1kg Dal (lentil), 1lit oil (Soyabin) and 1 kg salt to the 71 students.
  - **b) Education Materials:** 1piece School Bag, 1piece Umbrella, 1piece Lantern, 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the students. 5-packets of chalk to Jogahati 48 pre-school students and 3 packet of chalk to Churamankati 24 tuition students.
  - c) Hygiene Materials: 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to 99 students.
  - **d) Tuition Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
  - e) Awareness & Motivation: Before the each distribution, BS Officials follow-up the student study progress and motivate on importance and value of education among the students and parents.

Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Rexona Khatun, Mina Das & Sonia Akter also actively participates in the distribution programme.

### c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. Absent at School: During this month 4 student totally not went to school. In addition, most of reason the absent is change the living address and family problems. Community Motivator will closely follow-up those students during this month and shall identify the proper solution to solve.

# d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF February 2011

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

- 1. Audit and Approval: The 2010 project external financial audit is complete during the month. After complete the audit we shall submit the financial report to IDEA Onlus-Italy and the NGO Affairs Bureau of Bangladesh (NGOAB).
- **2. Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 22<sup>nd</sup> March.
