## **EDUCATION FOR ALL PROJECT Activities Monitoring Report: March 2010**

We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in March 2010.

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Eleven meeting are being conducted in the community, and especial topics include the importance of cleanliness, health & hygiene during the chickenpox and preventive measure for the pox.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month two adopted students & the parents meeting has been arranged in the community. In the meeting discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home etc. Also, include the special care instruction to the chickenpox effected children at home.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has been visited eleven times in five schools.
- 4. Special Medical Check-up: Two disabled girl LUCKY & ASMA has been visited to a specialist at Dhaka. The specialist suggests to LUCKY for special corrective shoes to prevention the tilting position during the walk and physiotherapy for tendo achillis tightness. For ASMA, specialist suggest to use corrective shoes, back-slab & elbow crutches and also the physiotherapy treatment for right leg hamstring & tendo achillis muscle tightness.
- **5. Pre-school:** Community Motivator took 4 classes in preschool on English, Bangla & Arithmetic beside the regular class routine.
- **6. Housing, IGA and Health Needs Discussion:** 20<sup>th</sup> March, we conducted discussion sessions at Jogahati community to get the estimation on Housing, IGA and Health needs.
- **7.** Churamonkati Community Visit: 22<sup>nd</sup> March, Bolai Das has been visited the newly selected Churamonkati community. He was excited to see the BS appropriate selection for the Education for All new project area.
- **8. Preschool New Initiatives:** To provide more effective education to the preschool students we introduce daily assembly, special class of CM, also included in curriculum the story books telling, cultural sessions, drawing class etc.

- After follow-up and investigation we found that most of reason to unable attendants at schools is Seasonal Fever and Chickenpox. Now in Bangladesh winter has passed and spring seasons are running, for the season change the students and children suffer the fever and chickenpox. We distributed nutrition food and conducted awareness on safety & hygiene issue during the chickenpox.
- **10. Distribution Programme:** 29<sup>th</sup> March we arranged the distribution programme for 62 students.
  - **Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 10kg Rice and 1kg Lentil/Dhal among the students.
  - **Tuition Support:** Provided tuition costs to Amlina for the month of March.
  - BS Team: In the distribution ceremony Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Nazmul Karm, Community Motivator; Sufia Khatun, Preschool Teacher; are attended the programme and distributed the materials to the students.

The following project activity plans are prepare for the month of May 2010:

- 1. Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings shall conduct at the community.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings shall arrange with the adopted student parents.
- 3. School Visits shall made by CM to follow-up students study and school attendance.
- **4. Community Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up community activities and conduct the development activities.
- **5. Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the distribution programme at 26<sup>th</sup> April.

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- **6. NGO Bureau Renewal:** We are waiting to get the approval of the "Education for All" renewal project from the NGO bureau for further 3-years.
- 7. **Need Base Survey:** We are going to conduct door to door survey at Jogahati Community to get the realistic needs for the Housing, IGA and Health support.
- 8. New PROJECT: Preparing the proposal & budget for the PRERONA-Project for participatory collaboration in disadvantaged community development, the project especially set out the development of the JOGAHATI community by housing, sanitary and income generation initiatives.
