Activities Monthly Report January 2011

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We passed a year and happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in January 2011.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Winter Cloth Distribution:** Friend of Banchte Shekha Professor of MM (Michael Madhusudan Dutt) Collage Prof. Mostafizur Rahman distributed generously blanket to the 15 elderly people of the Jogahati village. Along with the winter clothe also provides 1kg rice to each. We are very grateful and encourage the local people contribution.
- 2. Study Tour:** On 24th January, Jogahati children and tuition teachers went for the study tour at Shilaidaho, Kushtia to Robindronath Tagore house. Nobel laureate poet Rabindranath Tagore lived a part of his life at Shelaidaha in this district and created some of his memorable poems while living there. Students were thoroughly enjoyed the tour and it was great experience for them to out of the community a day adventure. The study tour cost covered from contribution from the staffs and families joint effort. Before student going back home during food packet distribution some trouble arises but later, we handle the situation efficiently.
- 3. New Adoption:** During this month 18 new adopted students has enrolled. The students are from 3 Churamankati, 5 Lolitadoho and 10 Mohishati villages.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings:** Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. **Two** meetings are being conducted in the community and the meeting topics is “student’s exam result and process of progress of results”.
- 2. Guardians’ Meetings:** During this month **one** adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student’s attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- 3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **ten times in ten schools**.
- 4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **11 times** at Jogahati village, **2 times** at Churamankati village, **1 times** at Lolitadaho village, and **1 times** at Mohishati village during this month.
- 5. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **63** students house in **63 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle’s care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- 6. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme:** During this month 3-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 63 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.
- 7. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme:** During this month, tuition teacher provide tuition support to 12 adopted and 24 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 36

students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school.

8. School Attendance: Now the **105** supported students are studying at **10** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

- **Attendance Summary:** Total number 105 students during the month 18 students attendance at schools 100 percent; 52 students attendance above 90 percent; 15 students attendance above 80 percent; 20 students are below 80 percent attendance at school.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason of students less school attendance is for fever and relative house visit.
- **Tuition Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. **January'11 Distribution:** Due to annual audit and approval process from the NGO bureau we were unable to distribute the January materials in time. We are planning to distribute the materials in before middle of the February'11.

d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF February 2011

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

- 1. Door-to-Door Survey:** At Sorupdaho community, a door-to-door survey will be conduct from **13 Feb to 18 Feb** to find out the number of disadvantage children.
- 2. Distribution:** January materials shall distribute on 10 February including school bag, umbrella, lantern, uniforms etc to the adopted students.
- 3. Audit and Approval:** The 2010 project external financial audit is complete during the month. After complete the audit we shall submit the financial report to IDEA Onlus-Italy and the NGO Affairs Bureau of Bangladesh (NGOAB).
