EDUCATION FOR ALL PROJECT Activities Monitoring Report: February 2010

We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in February 2010.

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Five meeting are being conducted in the community, and topics include the importance of education, cleanliness, health & hygiene, kitchen/yard gardening, dangers of early marriage, malnutrition and other issues, vital for the well being of their children etc.
- **2. Guardians' Meetings:** During this month one adopted students & the parents meeting has been arranged in the community. In the meeting discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home etc.
- 3. Special Student Meeting: According the January attendance report below 80% attendance achieved students are attend in a Special Student Meeting to find out the reason to less attendance and take action to improve the attendance. The several actions have been taken such as; motivation to inattentive students to not avoiding school, medicine for sickness, parent's motivation to avoid the unnecessary relative house visit etc.
- **4. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance in school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has been visited six times in four schools. One school not able to visit due to other activities involvement.
- 5. Emergency Support: Kousholla Rani of the Jogahati community has been injured while she is travelling by local vehicles. Immediately she has been supported by BS medical staff Rezwana to overcome the injury. Also, provide necessary medicine to early recovery. She now recover completely.
 - During medicine distribution we found a child name Amol, age 12 months have been suffering pneumonia. Immediately the child and parents bring to the Jessore Hospital. After thorough check-up doctor gave medicine, after that Amol and his parents stayed in BS premises for 3-days to further medical observation and medication, during staying also provide food and lodging. After recovering completely he has been back to village with supplementary food.
- **6. Emergency Action:** One student BS 0060 Rekha and BS 0005 Jugal was physically beaten by teacher for not doing home work and for absent. After receiving this information, immediately CM has been made an awareness discussion with class teachers and head teacher to not beating any student again. Also take special care to this student preparing the home work and motivating for regular school attendance.
- 7. **Medicine Distribution:** During this month in one session we have been distributed the medicine which has been prescribed by the Dr. Carmello in last medical camp. All the prescribed medicine has been distributed at community members. Especially we gave Paracetamol syrup/tablet, Cough syrup, Scabies, Vitamin Tablets and Anti-warm pills to 25 students.
- 8. Special Medical Check-up: Two disabled girl LUCKY & ASMA been visited to Italian Medical Team at Khulna. The medical team suggest to LUCKY that they shall visit her again in November 2010 for further medical examination/operation. For ASMA doctor suggest for the physiotherapy treatment.
- **9. New Community Find-out:** In 15, 22, 23 & 25 February sample community survey has been made in Churamonkati & Lolitadaho village to select the new community for the

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- renewal project. According the survey report we select the Churamonkati community for the next renewal project beside the Jogahati present activity.
- **10. New Profile:** We prepared 8 profiles during this month and sent to IDEA Onlus for the adoption process.
- **11. Project Completion and Audit Report:** After the audit we have submit the project completion report and audit report to IDEA Onlus.
- **12. School Attendance List:** The 62 students are studying at 5 different schools, the attendance reports are given below for your kind concern;

- After follow-up and investigation we found that most of reason to unattendant in school is Seasonal Fever. Now in Bangladesh winter has passed and spring seasons are come, for the season change the students and children suffer the fever and chickenpox. We distributed medicine to the students.
- Ashim Grandfather has been died for the old age, for that reason he absent in School for one day. Fulchan & Proshanto are Ashim cousin so, they also take leave.
- **13. Distribution Programme:** 28th February we arranged the distribution programme for 62 students.
 - Nutrition Materials: We distributed 10kg Rice, 3kg Potato, 2pieces Cabbage, 1ltr Soybean Oil and 1kg Salt among the students.
 - Education Materials: 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the students.
 - **Hygiene Materials**; 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to students.
 - Tuition Support: Provided tuition costs to Amlina for the month of February.
 - Awareness Song: During the programme Balai Das Baul sang some beautiful awareness song.
 - **BS Team:** In the distribution ceremony Executive Director, Angela Gomes; Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Monitoring Officer, Anowar Hossain are attended the programme and distributed the materials to the students.

The following project activity plans are prepare for the month of March 2010:

- 1. Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings shall conduct at community.
- **2. Guardians' Meetings** shall arrange with the adopted student parents.
- 3. School Visits shall made by CM to follow-up the study and school attendance.
- **4. Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the distribution programme in 29 March.
- **5. NGO Bureau Renewal:** We are going to submit the "Education for All" renewal project to NGO bureau for further 3-years.
