EDUCATION FOR ALL- PROJECT Activities Monitoring Report: May 2010

We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in May 2010.

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meeting are being conducted in the community, and especial topics include the importance of education, cleanliness, health & hygiene, kitchen/yard gardening, dangers of early marriage, malnutrition, care of pet goats/cows and other issues, vital for the well being of their children etc.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month one adopted students guardians meeting has arranged in the community. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians have actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited five times in three schools.
- **4. Community Visits:** During the month community motivator has been visit eighteen days to the Jogahati community and four time visits in Churamonkati village. The visits are made for implement the project activities; follow-up the community cleanliness, kitchen gardening, goats and cows caring; conduct community and guardians' meeting etc.
- **5. Pre-school:** Community Motivator took 2 classes in pre-school on English, Bangla & Arithmetic beside the regular class routine.
- 6. Special Support: By the financial help of Andrea Borghi Barbara Alfieri Family and Anna Maria Valletta Arturo Merrone Family, we provided two cows to two poorest families of the Jogahati Community. Under a terms and condition the cows has been distributed to the families to ensure care and avoid the selling of the cows. Also, ensure the vetonary supports to check-up and follow-up the cow's health regularly. We hope through this support the families able to accelerate their daily income in future.
- **7. School Attendance List:** The 73 supported students are studying at 5 different schools, the attendance reports are given below;

- **8. Distribution Programme:** 31st May we arranged the distribution programme for 73 students.
 - a) Nutrition Materials: We distributed 10kg Rice, 1kg Dal (lentil) among the students.
 - **b) Education Materials:** 1pair Shoe, 1piece School Bag, 1piece Umbrella and 1 piece Lantern to the new 11 students.
 - **c) Tuition Support:** Provided tuition costs to Amlina for the month of May.
 - **d)** Awareness Song: During the programme, Balai Das Baul sang some beautiful awareness song on cleanliness and family planning.

- e) BS Team: In the distribution ceremony BS Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Pre-school Teacher, Sufia Khatun; Micro-credit PO, Sohel Khan was attended the programme and distributed the materials to the students.
- **9. New Initiatives:** We distributed 48 writing slates and five packs of chalks to the Pre-school students. This support will help them to carry out their daily class lessons.
- **10. Disciplinary Action:** In last distribution programme BS0002 Maloti, BS0008 Monika and BS0044 Shohag was not attends and also without any prior notice visited in India & Dhaka, for that reason as a disciplinary action, we distributed their nutrition materials into the 6-beggar family in the Jogahati.

Also, during this month we found BS0001 Sufol, BS0008 Monika and BS0044 Shohag are not regular in school for that reason we stopped to distribution the nutrition materials to them and we are planning to distribute the materials to the 6-beggar family of Jogahati as disciplinary action.

BS0044 Shohag not going to school anymore because he has to earn money to feed his mother. Now he joined in a restaurant as daily worker to serve the customer. He was a very good and obedient student. His father died when he was child. An elder brother was run the family but now he did not supporting the family anymore so now Shohag have to work to feed his mother and run the family.

The following project activity plans are prepare for the month of June 2010:

- During the month four Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings shall conduct at the community.
- 2. During the month **Guardians' Meetings** shall arrange with the 73 adopted student parents in a three batch.
- 3. School Visits shall made by CM to follow-up students study and school attendance.
- **4. Community Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up community activities and conduct the development activities.
- **5.** Community motivator shall visit the **waiting list** students to follow-up at school and home.
- **6.** We are planning to arrange the **distribution** programme at 28th June.
- 7. We are waiting to get the **approval of the "Education for All"** renewal project from the NGO bureau for further 3-years.
- **8.** We shall going to submit the **PRERONA-Project** for participatory collaboration in disadvantaged community development, proposal to the NGO bureau.
