# Activities Monthly Report December 2010

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We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in December 2010.

Our children and staffs send their love and very best wishes for Merry Christmas and Happy New Year 2011 to IDEA Onlus Italy and all the families.

The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

#### a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

- 1. New Students Profile: We prepared 10 girls student profiles during this month and sent to IDEA Onlus for the adoption process. In the new profile, 5 students are from Churamankati village and 5 students are from Jogahati village.
- **2. Annual Examinations:** The Annual Examinations has finished during this month. All the students participated in the exam and made good result. Pre-school 48 students also given the exam and among them 20 students selected for the primary school enrolment in 2011.

#### **b.** THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meeting are being conducted in the community and the meeting topics is "Student Study Progress and Annual Exam Preparation" and its importance.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month one adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati and Churamankati community. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **eight times in eight schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up, the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **14 times** at Jogahati village, **6 times** at Churamankati village, **3 times** at Lolitadaho village, **4 times** at Sorupdaho village and **4 times** at Mohishati village during this month.
- **5. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **74** students house in **74 times** during this month. The door-to-door visit ensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. Pre-school:** We are happy to say that the Pre-school is running smoothly and that all activities have gone well. This month student actively participated in annual exam and 20 students have obtained for the primary education enrolment in 2011.
- 7. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme: During this month 3-tuition teachers provide tuition support to 51 students in 4-batch at Jogahati village. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school. Tuition programme ensure to support comprehend and prepare schools daily home works, class lessons and guide to improve the English, Arithmetic and Science subjects. Most of the students attend the annual exam and achieve good result.
- **8. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme:** During this month, tuition teacher provide tuition support to 9 adopted and 27 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 36 students receiving tuition support. Teacher ensuring the quality education support to the students after school. Tuition programme ensure to support comprehend and prepare schools daily home works, class lessons and guide to improve the English, Arithmetic and Science subjects. Most of the students attend the annual exam and achieve satisfactory result.

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**9. School Attendance:** Now the **89** supported students are studying at **8** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason of students absent at school is for winter cold, fever, and relative house visit.

# Notes:

- **Summary:** In the total student 89, at the exam 67 students has passed, 18 students failed and absent in exam 4 students. In the out of 67-passed student, 46 students have achieved the scholastic progress, 2 students' remains in same merit level and 19 students are declined.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason to fail and decline in exam is lack of intensive care at home. Please see the point-b in no. 2 for details explanation.
- **10. Distribution Programme:** We have set the date to distribution the materials in 27<sup>th</sup> December but due to Prime Minster programme at Jessore, the road has been blocked for while and unable to dispatch the materials at location. In next day 28<sup>th</sup> December, we distributed the materials to the students of Jogahati and Churamankati village. The distribution information is followings;
  - **a) Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 8kg Rice, 1kg Potato and 1kg Dal (lentil) to the 74 students.
  - **Education Materials:** 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the 85 students. 6-packets of chalk also distributed to the 48 pre-school students.
  - c) Hygiene Materials: 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to 85 students.
  - **Tuition Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
  - **e)** Awareness & Motivation: Before the distribution, begin BS Executive Director Angela Gomes and BS Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq speech on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
  - Team: In the distribution, ceremonies BS Executive Director Angela Gomes, Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq was present at the programme and distributed the materials to the students & parents. Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher-Sufia Khatun, Rexona Khatun, Mina Das & Sonia Akter also actively participates in the programme.

#### c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

- 1. Christmas & New Year Greetings: We are unable to send the greetings card to adopted parents of BS0095 Rokeya, because Rokeya family have changed the residence and now living another place.
- 2. Annual Exam Result: The children we have targeted have been the poorest, the most vulnerable and the outcasts in a society, which itself is very poor. The children have lack of nutrition and proper guidance from the family. The parents have lack of awareness and self-motivation. Even the parents just do not want to send their children to school.

  After we started the Education for All project gradually the parents start to send their children
  - to school, and they are enjoying it. Just last six months students start to receive the tuition support. We hope this year student's scholastic developments will be progress more. To ensure the scholastic development we will concentrate in following aspects;
  - To increase number of tuition teachers.

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- To ensure quality education by the tuition teachers.
- · To make the twice month home visit.
- To visit schools to check the attendance.
- To take special care with weak students.
- 3. To involve and orientation about the importance of Education for All and PRERONA Project to the local government officials, we were plan to invite them in November distribution programme. Due to government officials busy schedule not able to participate at December'10 distribution programme but promised that in very near future programme they will be participate.

### d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF January 2011

## Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in next month;

- 1. ID card Distribution: To identify the adopted students easily and provide the materials or support in organised way we have been print the students ID card and planning to distribute the ID card in January to every adopted student.
- **2. Dropout Students:** According the previous months report BS0005 Jugol, BS0007 Shushil, BS0043 Aktarul and BS0095 Rokeya has been dropout from the project. As replacement of this student, we will prepare and send 4 new student profile to IDEA.
- 3. Materials Distribution Policy: At present 89 students receiving support from the project. For malnutrition, extreme poverty and lack of regular fixed income, we are providing nutrition materials (such as Rice, Dhal, Potato, Oil and Salt) to the 77 student's family of Jogahati village. After almost one and half year project implementation, we found some families are able to elevating from the poverty and found alternative jobs to earn regular fixed income and for the drop-out reason we have to stop the support. For that reason and according the project policy, we are planning to eliminate some families from the nutrition materials distribution list of 2011. After starting of "Prerona" project at Jogahati, gradually we will close down the nutrition materials support and we will concentrate for the students Education support, Health & Hygiene and for the Tuition supports. 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However, the above students shall continuously receive the other supports such as Education, Health & Hygiene Materials and the Tuition supports. Through the nutrition materials saved money, we shall able to recruit more tuition teachers to provide more quality education.

- **4. Sorupdaho Initiatives:** BaSE Bangladesh partner and BS friends cum Donor, Vannozza della Seta Italy, recently visited Banchte Shekha activities especially the Rehabilitation Centre for the Disabled and the Education for All project at Jogahati. They are very impressed to see the valuable activities and provide some instant generous donation for the community. We are very grateful for this generous support and we are planning to build a school structure for the Sorupdaho community. The school structure will help us to start the pre-school and tuition programme for the disadvantaged children of that community.
- 5. Jogahati Contribution: BS friends and promising donor "In de bres voor Bangladesh" founder Nicole van Brunschot, Joyce van Brunschot and Els Tamminga- Neatherlands has visited BS activities especially the Rehabilitation Centre for the Disabled and the Education for All project at Jogahati. They very much impressed to see the valuable activities for the community. They proposed to setup a small playground for the children of Jogahati. In the playground community children able to enjoy, learn and recreate. We are going to submit a project proposal for the rehabilitation programme and we are planning to include the Jogahati Community Play Ground cost at the budget.
- **6. New Recruitment:** We are planning to recruit 4 new tuition teachers for the adopted students of Churamankati, Mahishati, Lolitadaho and Sorupdaho village. According requirements and necessity the tuition teachers shall also provide tuition support to limited numbers of non-adopted students. Tuition teachers shall ensure the students quality education, to understand and prepare the schools daily home works, class lessons especially the scholastic development on English, Arithmetic and Science subjects.
- 7. Pre-school Relocation & Reconstruction: During this month, we shall select a place for the relocation of the Jogahati pre-school in proper place. Present place have the lack of toilet, water and free space facilities. Therefore, new place selected with lots of much space where we can establish Toilets and other facilities. The school relocation & reconstruction process shall go forward with community people jointly effort. The people shall provide physical contribution to relocation and construction to the school.
- **8. Project Activities and Financial Report:** The 2010 project external financial audit shall proceed during the month. After complete the audit we shall submit the project annual activities and financial report to IDEA Onlus-Italy and the NGO Affairs Bureau of Bangladesh (NGOAB).
