# Activities Monthly Report November 2010

We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in November 2010. The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

# a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

- 1. Churamankati Tuition Programme: We started tuition programme at the Churamankati village. Total 21 students including 8 adopted students receiving tuition support. BS0125 Bristy & BS 0082 Biplob proposed waiting list students' family willingly provided the "veranda" to run the tuition programme.
- 2. Christmas Greetings Card: For the upcoming Christmas and New Year festival, we sent the greetings card to the individual parents address in Italy. Each greetings card sent along with the student letter and the recent photographs of family.

#### **b.** THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Two meeting are being conducted in the community and the meeting topics is "Bad Habits and How & Why to Change" and its importance.
- **2. Guardians' Meetings:** During this month **one** adopted students guardian meeting has arranged in the Jogahati and Churamankati community. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians are actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **thirteen times in seven schools**.
- **4. Community Visits:** To follow-up the community progress activities, Community Motivator has visited **17 times** at Jogahati village, **5 times** at Churamankati village, **2 times** at Lolitadaho village and **3 times** at Mohishati village during this month.
- **5. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers has visited **82** students house in **164 times** during this month. The door-to-door visitensure the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- **6. Pre-school:** We are happy to say that the Pre-school is running smoothly and that all activities have gone well. All the children are eager to learn and give a good reflection of the theme of **'STUDYING WITH HAPPINESS'.** Most of the children are very regular in their attendance.
- 7. JOGAHATI Tuition Programme: During this month 3-tuition teachers provide education support to 51 students in 4-batch. Teachers ensuring the quality education support to the students after school. Through the tuition programme students receiving support to understand and prepare the schools daily home works, class lessons and scholastic development on English, Arithmetic and Science subjects.
- **8. CHURAMANKATI Tuition Programme:** During this month tuition teacher, provide quality education support to 8 adopted and 21 not-adopted students in the Churamankati village. Total 29 students receiving tuition support.
- **9. School Attendance:** Now the **88** supported students are studying at **8** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

#### **Notes:**

- **Summary:** In the exam total 60 students has passed, 26 students failed and absent in exam 2 students. In the out of 60-passed student, 45 students have achieved the scholastic progress, 4 students' remains in same merit level and 11 students are declined.
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason to fail and decline in exam is lack of intensive quality education. Please see the point-b in no. 2 for details explanation.
- **10. Distribution Programme:** We have set the date to distribution the materials in 29<sup>th</sup> November but due to fund transaction problem we unable to procure the materials and distribute the items in time. Later on we procure the materials and able to distribute in 2<sup>nd</sup> December to the 88 students of Jogahati and Churamankati village. The distribution information is followings;
  - **a) Nutrition Materials:** We distributed 8kg Rice, 1kg Potato, 1kg Dal (lentil) and 1kg Salt to the 74 students.
  - **b) Education Materials:** 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the 87 students. 6-packets of chalk also distributed to the 48 pre-school students.
  - c) Hygiene Materials: 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap has been given to 87 students.
  - **Tuition Support:** The tuition fees given to the 4 students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
  - **Awareness & Motivation:** Before the distribution, begin Professore Moqsudul Haq speech on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
  - f) Team: In the distribution, ceremonies Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Moqsudul Haq was present at the programme and distributed the materials to the students & parents. Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Rexona Khatun, Mina Das & Sonia Akter also actively participates in the programme.

## c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

- 1. **BS0005 Jugol and BS0007 Shushil:** We shall introduce them to PRERONA project for Vocational Training which ensure there future self-employment and in there replacement we should introduce new students.
- **2. BS0043 Aktarul:** Suddenly Aktarul family has been change their living location and migrate to another place. For that reason, he is not available for the adoption support from the project. We request to new student in his replacement.
- **3. BS0095 Rokeya:** Recently Rokeya has been adopted for the next year programme from Mohishhati village but during our follow-up we found that family have left the colony and moved to the grandfather place and neighbour confirmed that they will not return again. Request to cancel her adoption and replace a new student.
- **4. Second Term Exam Result:** In second term exam, we found little scholastic improvement than first term exam. One month before the second term exam, we have started the tuition programme for the community. Therefore, the teachers get short time to prepare the student for exam. We do hope that in next annual exam tuition programme will bring the remarkable scholastic improvement to the students.
- 5. To involve and orientation about the importance of Education for All and PRERONA Project to the local government officials, we were plan to invite them in November distribution programme. Due to government officials busy schedule not able to participate at November '10 distribution programme but promised that in very near future programme they will be participate.

## d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF December

- **1. Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings** shall conduct at the community. The meetings topic would be "Unity & Development".
- 2. Guardians' Meetings shall arrange with the 88 adopted student parents in a four batch.
- 3. School Visits shall made by CM to follow-up students study and school attendance.
- **4. Community Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up community activities and conduct the development activities. In the period, CM shall visit Jogahati 12 times, Churamonkati 2 times, Lolitadoho 1 times, Mohishhati 1 times and Sorupdaho 3 times.
- 5. During the month door-to-door visit shall continue by the Tuition Teachers and CM to adopted student houses for follow-up the study at home, to solve the family issues, to check domestic cattle's, to see cleanliness, to ensure utilisation of the distributed materials and ensure implementation of kitchen gardening's.
- **6.** Sorupdaho is a village of Sharsha Upazila of Jessore District. In that village nearly 70 ultra-poor families living, they are not only poor they had taken loan but unable to refund it (due to unproductive investment and proper guidance) for that reason they now living more miserable life. The most of community people does not have the regular source of income and the children not going to school due to poverty and the government school situated in 2km. distance from the community. To bring the community children under light of the education, we are planning to recruit a Tuition Teacher and start the tuition programme at the community and the tuition teacher salary cost will be cover from the Education for All project saved money.
