THE INTERN'S CORNER;

My name is Edoardo and I am glad to write to you about my experience in Bangladesh. I completed my undergraduate degree at Bocconi University in this month and I got the chance to do three months internship for IDEA-Onlus at Banchte Shekha. In this period I will follow the "Education for All" project, working both in the office, with the project co-ordinator Shourove, and in the villages, with the Community Motivator Shoriful.

The aim of this section is to provide a firsthand impression of the situation from the field, attached with interesting facts and stories about the everyday life of the adopted students. I have not the presumption to tell you the whole reality; I will just provide my point of view, hoping that this will shorten the big distance between you and this beautiful country.

I arrived in Jessore on the 19th of September, starting to learn about Banchte Shekha and the project carried on by IDEA. In these firsts weeks of work In Bangladesh I visited the five villages supported by Education for All, trying to have an overall picture of the project and of the villagers' conditions. Although I came by at each village few times and regardless my lack of Bangla knowledge, something on which I am working on, I can share with you my initial impressions.

Jogahati, "hometown" of most of the adopted kids, is the place that fascinated me the most. It is surrounded by green fields of rice and a really beautiful river. Even though is really poor, economically speaking, all the families are really welcoming and cheerful. I have got the luck to visit Jogahati in the morning when the preschool program was going on. It was really surprising that all the attending kids, from 3 to 6 years old, not only were composed but also were able to spell correctly all the English alphabet and numbers up to ten. I think that, for them, this knowledge will be an important asset the day they will start going to primary school.

After looking up most of the student's house in the five villages I have seen that the places, almost dark and with no space available, are not suited for studying children. They cannot even relay on their parent's help for homework due to their illiteracy and all-day-busyng jobs. The program, providing an appropriate place and professional teachers deeply committed, represent a turning point for most of the student's educational path.

During the material distribution's days I have seen the proud and joyful faces of the adopted children's parents. They do understand the benefits of the program for their daughters and sons, and this awareness will eventually motivate all the families of the community to send their children to school.

These are just my first impression and I am sure that within the next three months I will be able to share with all of you other experiences and thoughts.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES

- 1. Teachers in Red:** Now all our teachers are in red!!! Not because for the anger but for wearing the new Sari. As uniform, teachers selected red sari's and they look really beautiful. Now they are look like a team and hope they work as a team. Furthermore these new uniform will help the students to pay more attention in the class.

2. Education Graphical Data Base: From this month we will provide, attached to the monthly report, an excel file that gives you the opportunity to know each student's educational information. There are detailed information and historical series of data.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

- 1. Guardians' Meetings:** During this month, **6** guardian meeting was arranged at Jogahati, Churamankati, Lolitadaho, Mohishati and Sorupdaho village. In these meetings, we discuss on the role of the parents at home and student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. In the meetings, Guardians participated actively.
- 2. School Visits:** During the month, to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, the Community Motivator visited **twelve schools**.
- 3. Community Visits:** To follow-up the community progress activities, Community Motivator visited **8 times** Jogahati village, **4 times** Churamankati village, **4 time** Lolitadaho village, **4 times** Mohishati and **5 times** Sorupdaho village during this month.
- 4. Door-to-door Visits:** To follow-up the students study at home, Tuition Teachers and Community Motivator together and separately visited all the **130** student's houses during this month. The door-to-door visit ensures the family progresses for domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, proper utilization of the distributed materials, kitchen gardening etc.
- 5. Tuition Programme:** To improve the school attendance, motivate and overall scholastic development tuition programmes are in service. The monthly data as follows;

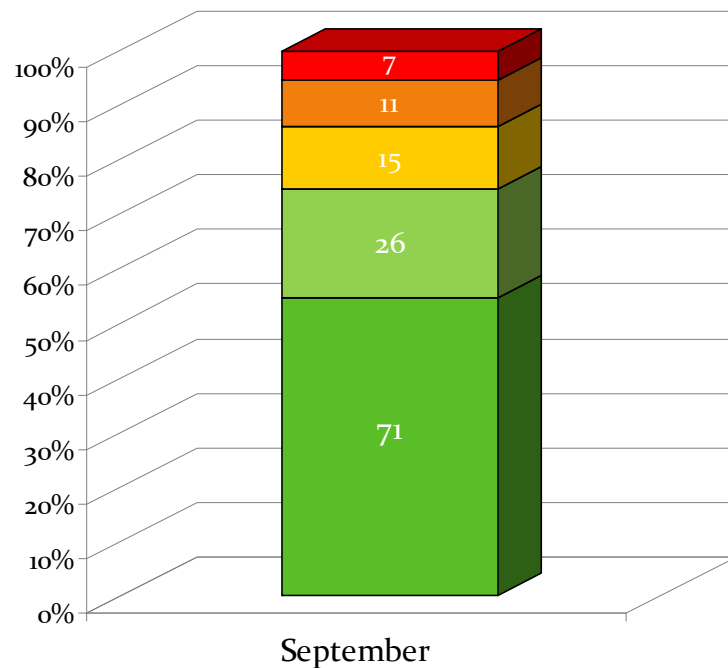

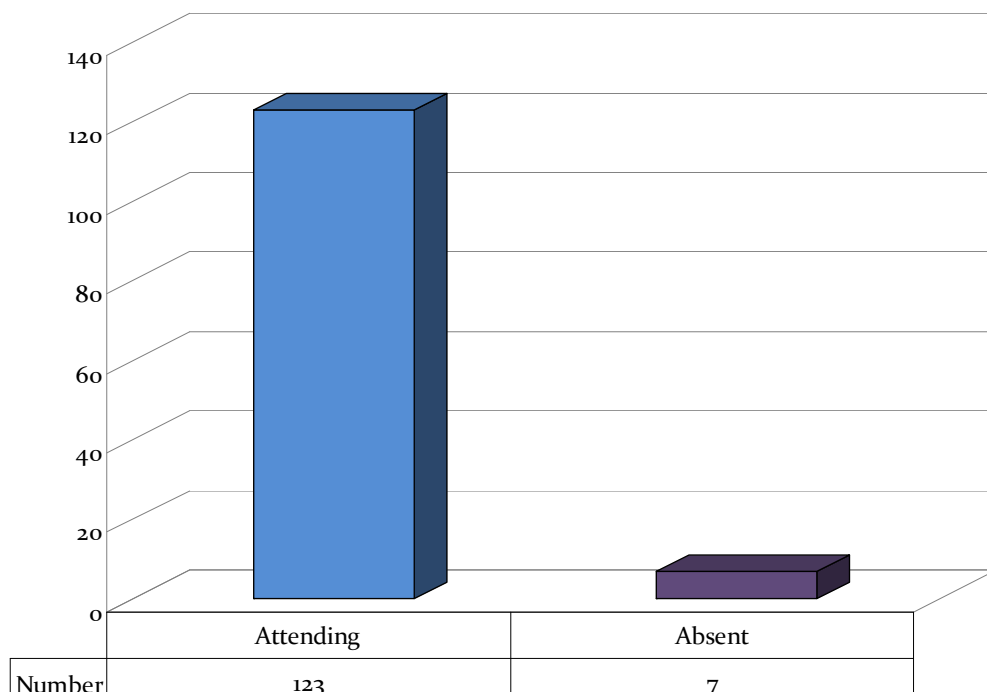
- **Attendance Summary:** This month some student attendants were less at school because of Continues Heavy Rain. Although out of total number 130 adopted students during this

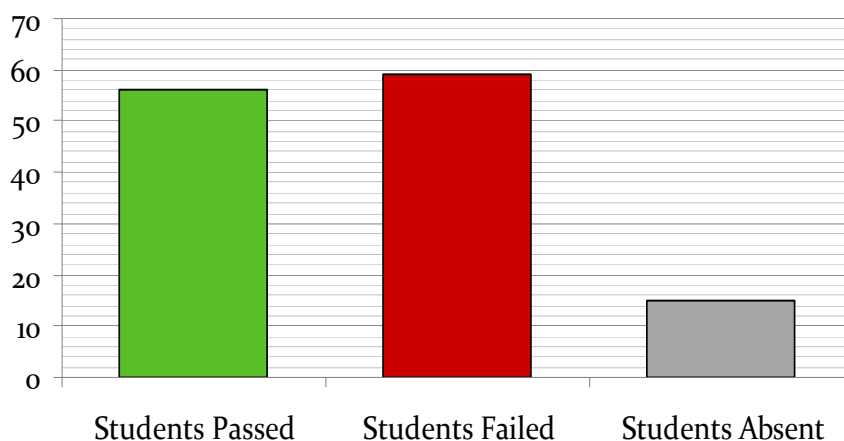

8. **Distribution Programme:** We distributed the materials in 27th at Jogahati & Churamankati; 28th at Lolitadaho & Mohishati; and 29th at Sorupdaho. Due to absent among the 130 students, total 109 students receive the following support during this month;

- a) **Nutrition Materials:** To ensure basic nutrition support to the Jogahati extreme poor. We distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato, 1kg Dal (lentil), 1ltr Soybean Oil, 1kg Salt to the 51 adopted students and families.
- b) **Education Materials:** To support for regular study we distributed 1piece Copy Books, 1piece Eraser, and 1piece Pen to 109 adopted students. Also, distributes 6 packets of chalk for the tuition and pre-school programme.
- c) **Hygiene Materials:** To cleanliness and personal-hygiene, we distribute 1piece Body Soap and 1piece Washing Soap to 109 adopted students.
- d) **Tuition Support:** To cover the education expenses, we provided tuition fees to the 4 adopted students (BS0023 Alryma & Amlina Sarkar and BS0098 Karuna Rani Das & BS0099 Boishakhi Rani Das).
- e) **Awareness & Motivation:** Before the distribution, BS Intern Guest and Officials follow-up the student study progress, cleanliness and motivate on importance and value of education among the students and parents.
- f) **Team:** In the distribution, ceremonies Intern Mr. Edoardo Trimarchi; BS Governing Body-Treasurer, Mr. Khondaker Moqsudul Haq; General Body- Member, Mr. Mohammad Shajahan was present at the programme and distributed the materials. Community Motivator, Mr. Shoriful Islam; Tuition Teachers- Miss. Sufia Khatun, Mrs. Mina Das, Mrs. Shamimunnahar, Miss. Shila Khatun, Miss. Sonia Akter, Miss. Moushumi Jahan, Miss. Anjuara Begum, Miss. Tohmina Khatun, Miss. Sharmin Akhtar also actively participated in the distribution programmes.

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

1. **School Attendance:** To increase the school attendance of all students, in the month of October, we will keep communicating with parents and students, to motivate them to bring back their kids at school.
2. **Exam Result:** Last exam's result disappointed us. Students still does not receive proper attention and motivation from the family. In order to change the situation before the final exam in December we are implementing a new action plan to overcome these problems and improve the exam results. It consists on:
 - Improving supervision and follow-up to tuition teachers by the Community Motivator.
 - Arranging TOT programme (Training of Teachers). It will help to develop the tuition teachers teaching skill.
 - Visiting more frequently student's home to follow-up and supervise the students' study at home.
 - Visiting schools and homes to check the attendance.
 - Focusing on weak students, providing them special care.
 - Increasing the responsibility of the teachers to incentive good results.

d. ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR MONTH OF October 2011

Beside the regular activities of the project following initiative shall take in upcoming month:

- 1. Art Competition:** To motivate and inspire the children in arts we are going to organise an art competition among the Tuition Programmes and Pre-school students. The artwork will be judge and we will assign an award for the best drawing. The best design will be select for the BS 2011 Christmas Greetings Card.
- 2. Teachers Co-ordination Meeting:** Monthly teacher co-ordination meeting will be hold in 10th October.
- 3. Materials Distribution:** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme in 23rd, 24th and 25th October.

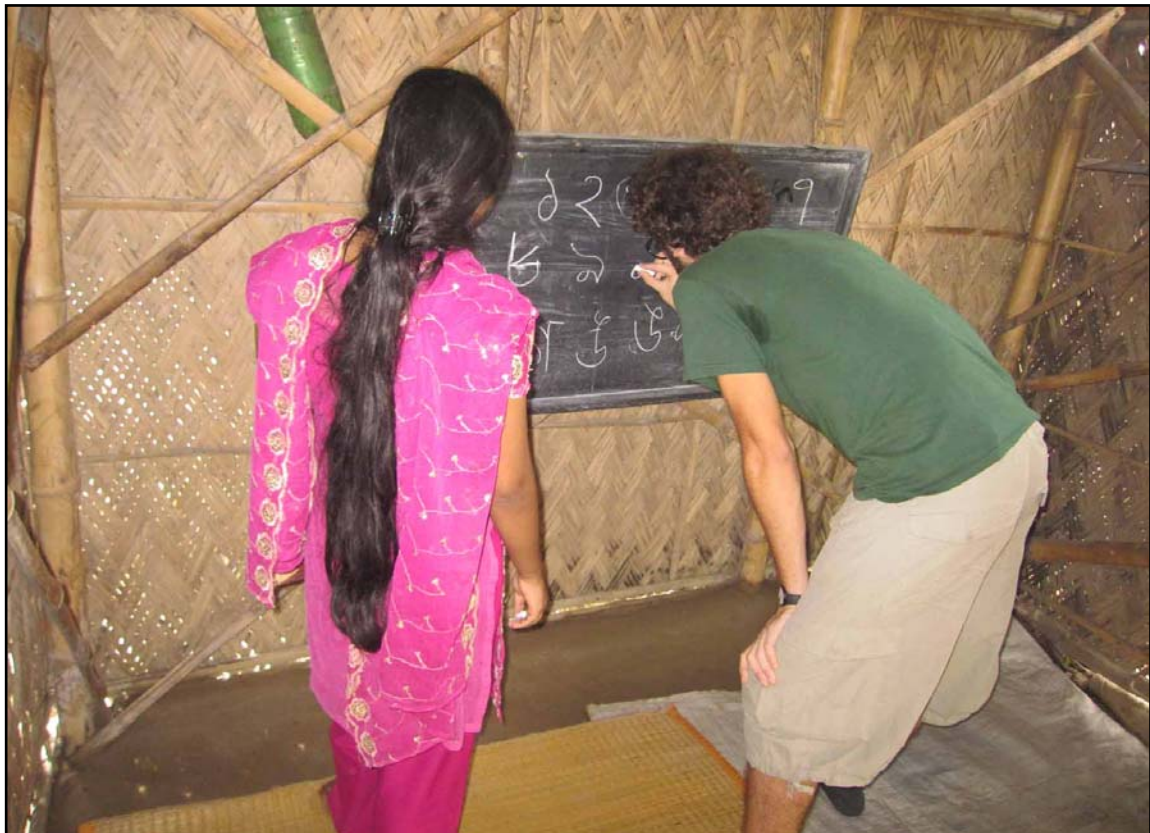
