Activities Monitoring Report September 2010

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We are happy to introduce ourselves with you again, and to tell you about all the activities that have been happening in September 2010. The following is a discussion of the major works undertaken during the reporting period and the plan for the next month.

a. THE NEW INITIATIVES/ACTIVITES:

- 1. **New Profile:** We prepared and sent 3 new students profiles to IDEA Onlus for the adoption process. Also, update the files BS0080 to BS0097 serials, during Maria's visit we have reordered the profiles according the financial status of the children families.
- 2. Reports and News: During the month, we prepared and sent congratulation to Italian adopted parents Andrea & Ambra for their marriage ceremony on behalf of adopted child BS0068 Mithun family. We sent the photographs and report too.
- **3. Housing Support:** Binoy and BS0024 Konika house under in re-construction and repairing by the financial support of the adopted Italian family of Konika.

The families living condition was inadequate and broken. Every rainy season Binoy house was under the water due to house location was government land and living in the bank of the big water resource. In addition, Konika family require extra kitchen and tin roof.

Therefore, through the **Sofia e Paul** family contribution Binoy relocate the house to his father-in-law gifted land and build new house. Konika's family also roof with the tin shade and repair the house.

In the construction and repairing process, families contribute physically.

Now Binoy and Konika's family have basic shelter for living. They are very grateful to **Sofia e Paul** family for the generous help.

- 4. Community Contribution: To involve the parents in the project more and grow up the interest about their child education, we introduced an idea about the community contribution to the School. The parents appreciate the idea and according the financial status from this month family start to provide contribution to support Pre-school running costs. In a register the money received by the tuition teachers and CM monitor the transaction regularly. Through this fund, we shall purchase the required materials for the school such as; games materials, sometime chocolate or sweets as tiffin.
- **5. Second Terminal Exam:** The second terminal exam was held in pre-school and the government's schools. The entire student participated to the exam and we hope to publish the results in next month.
- **6. BS0008 Monika:** Finally Monika starts going to school regularly. In addition, she is very attentive in tuition classes. After couple of months later, she set her mind again for the study. The tuition teachers help her to overcome the problems. Well-done teachers!!!
- **7. PRERONA Project Approval:** After long delay, finally the NGO Bureau of Bangladesh Government has approved the PRERONA project for 3-years. We are start to implement the project soon.

b. THE ROUTINE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED:

- 1. Monthly Motivational Meetings: Motivational/Awareness meetings are held during the month, to try to make community people realise their responsibilities at community and their role in the process of family and community development. Three meeting are being conducted in the community, and especial topics include the importance of education, cleanliness, health & hygiene, kitchen/yard gardening, dangers of early marriage, malnutrition, care of cattle's and other issues, vital for the well being of their children etc.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings: During this month one adopted students guardians meeting has arranged in the community. In the meeting, discuss on role of the parents at home, student's attentiveness into the study at school & home. The Guardians have actively participates in the meetings.
- **3. School Visits:** During the month to check the attendance at school of the adopted students, Community Motivator has visited **eleven times in four schools**.

- **4. Pre-school:** Community Motivator took 6 classes in pre-school on English, Bangla & Arithmetic beside the regular class routine.
- **5. Community Visits:** During the month, CM visited **17 times** at Jogahati village and **1 times** at Churamankati village.
- **6. Door-to-door Visits:** During this month **72** students house has been visits **144 times** for follow-up the students study & family progress such as domestic cattle's care, cleanliness of house & dresses, utilisations of the distributed materials and kitchen gardening etc.
- 7. Tuition Programme: During this month 3-tuition teachers provide special education support to 52 students in a 4-batch. Tuition teachers are giving emphasis to develop scholastic development of the English, Arithmetic and Science subjects.
- **8. School Attendance List:** Now the **73** supported students are studying at **5** different schools, the school attendance reports are given below;

- Summary: This month 100 percent attendance at school, are 57; above 90 percent attendance at school are 7; above 80 percent attendance at school are 7; below 80 percent attendance at school are 2.
 - BS0005 Jugal and BS0007 Shushil was totally un-attendant at School. Reason for unattendants at school is described in point-b no. 1 & 2.
- These months less day's schools are open due to the Eid vacation (Muslims Festival).
- After follow-up and investigation, the most reason of unattended at school of some students is fever and relative house visit.
- 9. Distribution Programme: Due to delay supplies of materials from the suppliers, we postpone the 27th September distribution programme and distributed in 28th September to the 73 students.
 - a) Nutrition Materials: We distributed 8kg Rice, 2kg Potato, 1kg Dal (lentil) and 1kg Salt to the 72 students.
 - b) Education Materials: 1piece Copy Books and 1piece Pen to the 52 students. 5 packet chalks provided to pre-school for 48 students.
 - c) Hygiene Materials; 1 piece Body Soap and 1 piece Washing Soap has been given to 72 students.
 - d) Tuition Support: The tuition costs to Amlina for the month of September are given.
 - e) BS Team: In the distribution ceremony Governing Body-Treasurer, Khondaker Mogsudul Hag; General Body- Member, Mohammad Shajahan; Community Motivator, Nazmul Karim; Tuition Teacher- Sufia Khatun, Rexona Khatun & Mina Das was attended the programme and distributed the materials to the students.

c. PROBLEMS AND RECTIFICATIONS

- 1. After many counselling and motivation BS0005 Jugol not attending in School and with any reason BS0007 Shushil absent in School so, as learning we did not distribute the materials of September to them. Hope they will continue the class again soon.
 - BS0005 Jugol and BS0007 Shushil materials we have been distributed to 4 poor widow women in the Jogahati Community.

d. ACTIVITIES ARE PLANNED FOR MONTH OF OCTOBER

- 1. Monthly Awareness & Motivational Meetings shall conduct at the community. The meetings topic would be Early Marriage prevention and Health & Hygiene.
- 2. Guardians' Meetings shall arrange with the 72 adopted student parents in a four batch.

- 3. School Visits shall made by CM to follow-up students study and school attendance.
- **4. Community Visits** shall made by CM to follow-up community activities and conduct the development activities. In the month CM shall visit Jogahati 15 times, Churamonkati 2 times, Lolitadoho 1 times, Mohishhati 1 times and Sorupdaho 1 times.
- **5.** Community Motivator shall take 5 classes in **pre-school** and 10 classes in **tuition programme** on English, Bangla & Arithmetic beside the regular class routine.
- **6.** During the month **door-to-door visit** shall continue by the Tuition Teacher and CM to adopted student houses for follow-up the study at home, to solve the family issues, to check domestic cattle's, to see cleanliness, to ensure utilisation of the distributed materials and support to implementation of kitchen gardening's.
- 7. Community motivator shall visit the **waiting list** students to follow-up at school and home.
- **8.** We are planning to arrange the next **distribution** programme at 25th October.
- **9.** Through the financial support of Maria Nicolino (Maria's Mother-in-Law), we are planning to support BS0044 Shohag family to generation their daily income as food security sustainability.
